ELY'S COMPLETE-GAME SHUTOUT ANCHORS TWIN-BILL SWEEP: Starter John Ely tossed a complete-game shutout as the Albuquerque Isotopes claimed a doubleheader sweep of the Tucson Padres with a 4-0 win in the first game and 7-2 victory in the second contest on Wednesday night at Isotopes Park. Ely held the Padres scoreless through his 7.0-inning complete game, scattering six hits while walking just one en route to his PCL-best 12th win on the season. Albuquerque scored all the runs it would need in the fourth inning on a three-run homer by Ivan De Jesus Jr, giving the 'Topes a 3-0 advantage. The Isotopes added an insurance run in the fifth when Scott Van Slyke smacked a one-out double to center and scored on a single from Matt Angle, sending Albuquerque coasting to a 4-0 game one victory. Trailing 2-1 in the fifth inning of the second contest, the Isotopes' offense got rolling when Josh Fields laced an RBI single to tie the score 2-2. Scott Van Slyke then poked an RBI single to left, giving the 'Topes a 3-2 edge. Albuquerque ran away with the contest in the sixth, scoring four runs thanks to Elian Herrera, who belted a three-run triple and promptly scored on a double by De Jesus to extend the lead to 7-2. Starter Derrick Loop delivered a quality start, allowing only two runs on three hits through 6.0 innings of work in which he struck out five and walked two. Following his departure from the contest, relievers Erick Threets and Josh Wall closed out the seventh to preserve a 7-2 'Topes win.

NIEVE'S NIGHT: Right-hander Fernando Nieve takes the mound riding a stretch of four straight no-decisions, a span in which he's posted a 3.63 ERA (9 ER / 22.1 IP). Nieve's last victory came on July 13 at Nashville, which happened to be his first and to this point only win away from Isotopes Park. Although he has just one victory, Nieve has thrived on the road of late, posting a 2.00 ERA (4 ER / 18.0 IP) over his last three starts away from Albuquerque. The right-hander also remains one of the most consistent pitchers in the PCL over the last month. Since July 1, Nieve's ERA of 2.88 (11 ER / 34.1 IP) is the ninth-lowest in the Pacific Coast League.

BIGGEST LITTLE CITY: Due to PCL realignment, the Isotopes are making just their second visit to Reno in franchise history and first since 2009. Albuquerque visited Aces Ballpark during Reno's inaugural season and, after the Aces moved from the PCL's Pacific Southern Division to the Northern Division, ended up hosting Reno in both 2010 and 2011. Regardless of where they've played, the 'Topes have enjoyed some success against the Aces. The Isotopes have won every series they've played against Reno, going 9-3 all-time against the Aces.

MIGHTY MO': Albuquerque heads into this pivotal eight-game road trip against Reno and Colorado Springs coming off a doubleheader sweep of Tucson, the second twin-bill the 'Topes have swept this season (7/29 at NVL), marking the first time in team history the Isotopes have taken both games of a doubleheader twice in a single year. Albuquerque also dives into its showdown with first-place Reno with its largest lead of the season in the PCL's American Southern Division. The Isotopes currently have a 4.0 game lead on second-place New Orleans and a 4.5-game advantage on suddenly swooning Oklahoma City.

SANDS RETURNS: The Isotopes' offense is bolstered by the return of Jerry Sands, who returns to the 'Topes after a short trip to the Dodgers. After getting recalled on August 6, Sands appeared in one game for Los Angeles that night against Colorado, going 0-for-3 while starting in right field. The outfielder was then optioned back to Albuquerque on August 8 to make room for Adam Kennedy, who is returning to the Dodgers after recovering from a groin strain. Before departing for the Major Leagues, Sands was arguably the PCL's hottest hitter, collecting a hit in each of his last 10 Pacific Coast League games, a span in which he was batting a scorching .476 (20x42) with six homers and 21 RBI.

A THREET IN THE BULLPEN: Since joining the Isotopes on July 18, lefty reliever Erick Threets has allowed a run in just one of his eight total outings and has yielded just two hits in his last six appearances combined (5.0 IP). Left-handed batters have just a .143 (2x14) average against Threets since he joined Albuquerque.

STRETCH RUN BEGINS NOW!: Yesterday, the Isotopes enjoyed their last day off of the 2012 season. Tonight begins a stretch of 25 straight games extending to the end of the regular season. With any luck, Albuquerque's next day off will be on September 4 and will be spent preparing for the Isotopes' opening round playoff series.

TODAY'S START: Fernando Nieve makes the start coming off his fourth straight solid no-decision on August 4 when he worked 5.1 innings, allowing four runs on six hits while walking six and striking out five in a 6-4 'Topes win. Pitched 6.0 shutout innings on July 13 at Nashville, his second shutout performance of the season, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out six in a 7-0 'Topes win. The victory was his second in as many starts. Had his best outing of the season on June 8 vs. Memphis when he authored 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out two in a 12-0 'Topes win. Had an excellent outing on May 27 vs. Oklahoma City when he was pressed into service on three days rest when Michael Antonini was scratched and pitched 5.0 solid innings, allowing a run on three hits while walking one and striking out a season-high seven in an 11-9 win. Missed 15 days while on the Disabled List recovering from a hamstring strain. After 2.0 innings at New Orleans on April 26, Nieve came out to warm up for the third but could no further, leaving the game with a strained hamstring. The right-hander was placed on the DL the next day. Also had an outing on April 18 vs. Iowa at Isotopes Park that was truncated by an ejection. With two outs in the top of the third, Nieve hit Anthony Rizzo with a pitch and was immediately ejected by home plate umpire Mike Jarboe, ending the right-hander's day after 2.2 innings in which he allowed three runs on four hits while walking none and striking out three. Albuquerque went on to win the game 6-4. Enjoyed a terrific outing in the 'Topes' home opener on April 13 when he held the Omaha Storm Chasers to four runs, three earned, on seven hits in six strong innings of a 7-4 'Topes win. His start Isotopes Park debut stood in stark contrast to his season debut at Omaha on April 8, when he lasted just 1.2 innings, allowing nine runs on 11 hits while walking two and striking out two in a 17-11

2011: Spent a majority of the season pitching for the Doosan Bears in the Korean Baseball Organization... appeared in 25 games going 3-6 and a 6.09 ERA... finished the season tied for third on the team with six saves... also fanned 66 batters which ranked fourth amongst Bears pitchers... started the season with Triple-A Oklahoma City in the Houston organization where he made three starts for the RedHawks, going 1-2 with a 7.63 ERA (13 ER / 15.1 IP)... granted his release on April 27.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the majority of the 2010 season with New York (NL)... was Designated for Assignment on July 23rd and optioned to Triple-A Buffalo on July 27... made 40 appearances for New York and had one start, May 29 at Milwaukee, an 8-6 loss... in 2.0 innings, he gave up three hits, five runs, all earned, with three walks and five strikeouts... became the first pitcher in Mets franchise history to appear in 19 of the team's first 30 games... picked up victories in relief vs. the Cubs on April 19 (1.1 scoreless innings with one hit) and vs. Detroit at Citi Field on June 22 (2.1 innings, no hits, no runs, with a walk and four strikeouts)... in seven June games, went 1-0 with a $3.12\ ERA$ (3 ER / $8.2\ IP$ and eight hits)... worked a career-best 10.2 consecutive scoreless innings in nine appearances from April 17-May 3, giving up five hits, with three walks and 10 strikeouts... struck out a season-high four in 2.1 innings vs. Detroit on June 22... went a season-best 3.0 innings vs. Cincinnati on July 5, permitting one run on three hits... made eight straight starts for Buffalo upon his return to the Bisons... scored backto-back victories against Scranton Wilkes-Barre on August 11 and against Pawtucket on August 16... went at least 6.0 innings in four of his eight Triple-A starts.

In 2009 went to Spring Training with Houston... was claimed off waivers by New York (NL) on March 13 and assigned to Double-A Binghamton... promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on May 18 and had his contract purchased by the Mets on June 5... placed on the 15-Day Disabled List on July 20 with a muscle tear in his right thigh and did not pitch for the rest of the season... tore the muscle during his start on July 19 at Atlanta... finished the season with the best ERA of his career (2.95)... Major League batters went hitless against him with runners in scoring position and two out (0-for-10)... made his Mets debut on June 6 with 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen in a 7-1 loss at Washington, allowing one hit and striking out two... beat St. Louis with 6.0 shutout innings on June 24 at home to establish a career-best three game winning streak... became the first Mets pitcher to win his first three starts with the team since Jorge Sosa in 2007... also tied his career-best scoreless streak with the 6.0 shutout innings on June 24.
