# **ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (68-52) AT RENO ACES (71-49)**

'TOPES TRUMPED BY ACES, 22-8: A season-high five RBI by Tim Federowicz was no match for an offensive onslaught as the Albuquerque Isotopes were drubbed by the Reno Aces 22-8 Friday night at Aces Ballpark. Reno came out swinging in the bottom of the first, scoring five times courtesy in part to a two-run homer by Mike Jacobs and a solo shot by Taylor Harbin before plating four more in the third to grab a 9-0 lead. Albuquerque finally answered in the fourth in a rally ignited by a oneout single from Jerry Sands and a walk to Scott Van Slyke. With two runners on, Federowicz smashed a three-run shot to right, trimming the lead to 9-3 Aces. Ivan De Jesus Jr. kept the rally going with a double and promptly scored on a single by pitcher Cole St. Clair, bringing the Isotopes within 9-4. Reno scored again in the fourth to make the score 10-4 but the 'Topes rallied one more time in the fifth. Federowicz hammered a double to right, plating two and cutting the deficit to just four runs at 10-6. Four runs proved to be as close as the visitors would get, as the Aces delivered the knock-out punch in the bottom of the fifth. With two outs, Reno scored 10 times, including three runs that were plated via bases-loaded walks or hit-by-pitches. When the frame finally ended, the Aces sent 15 men to the plate, collecting four hits (three doubles) and four walks. Albuquerque added a run in the eighth and another in the ninth, but the late rally was in vain as Reno tacked on two more in the bottom of the eighth to coast to a 22-8 win.

FIFE FEVER: Stephen Fife makes his first start since his second stint with the Dodgers, with whom he made a pair of starts. On July 27, Fife turned in a solid no-decision at San Francisco, pitching 6.1 innings in which he allowed one run on six hits while walking three and striking out two in an eventual 5-3 LA win in 10 innings. The right-hander stayed in the rotation and made the start on August 1 vs. Arizona, going 4.1 innings, allowing two runs on six hits while walking three and striking out four in a 4-0 Dodgers loss. On August 6, Fife was optioned back to Albuquerque after Los Angeles acquired pitcher Joe Blanton from Philadelphia and made his only relief appearance of the season that night, pitching 1.2 innings vs. Tucson. In three total starts in the Major Leagues this season, Fife is 0-1 with a 2.16 ERA (4 ER / 16.2 IP).

**CROOKED NUMBERS:** Last night's 22 run deluge was the second-most runs allowed by Isotopes pitchers in team history, coming two tallies shy of the team record of 24 suffered vs. Oklahoma on June 22, 2004. In franchise history, the 'Topes have only surrendered 20 runs or more six times, with last night's defeat being the first time 20 runs have been scored on Albuquerque away from Isotopes Park. Isotopes pitchers have yielded 20 runs in a game four times (8/22/07 vs. Memphis, 9/1/07 vs. Oklahoma, 6/7/10 vs. Memphis, and 8/30/10 vs. Iowa). The 10 runs given up in the fifth inning last night ties a franchise mark, set three previous times, the last coming on May 24 of last year in the ninth inning of a game vs. Colorado Springs.

ROAD WEARY: Dating back to their last road trip at Nashville, the Isotopes have dropped three straight games away from Isotopes Park. Prior to returning home on August 1, the 'Topes dropped back-to-back games against the Sounds on July 30 and July 31. Albuquerque's longest road losing streak is four games, set two times (May 31-June 3; June 29-July 2). The Isotopes are 4-6 in their last 10 games away from The Lab.

FED ON FIRE: The hottest hitter in the Pacific Coast League through the first 10 games of August is 'Topes catcher Tim Federowicz, who leads the PCL with a .500 (14x28) batting average in the month of August. Last night, Federowicz collected

a season-high five RBI while going 3-for-5 with a double and a homer. In fact, the top three hitters in the league in August are all Isotopes. Ranking just behind Federowicz is Matt Angle (.484- 15x31) and Ivan De Jesus Jr. (.448-13x29).

21 JUMP STREET: Albuquerque has spent a season-high 21 straight days on top of the PCL's American Southern Division and have 4.0-game lead over second-place New Orleans, the Isotopes' largest lead of the season. With the way the competition is playing, the 'Topes have a golden opportunity to seize control of the division. Oklahoma City has dropped seven in a row and nine of its last 10, while New Orleans is 5-5 in its last 10 contests.

TODAY'S START: Stephen Fife makes his first start since returning from a brief stay with the Dodgers, with whom he make a pair of starts. Suffered his first big league defeat on August 1 vs. Arizona, when he pitched 4.1 innings, allowing two runs on six hits while walking three and striking out four in a 4-0 Dodgers loss. Had a solid no-decision at San Francisco on July 27, pitching 6.1 innings and allowing one run on six hits while walking three and striking out two in a 5-3 LA win in 10 innings. Fanned a season-high 12 on July 22 vs. Iowa, allowing one run on four hits in 7.0 innings in a 9-5 loss. Made his Major League debut with Los Angeles on July 17, when the right-hander filled in for an injured Chad Billingsley. Facing the Philadelphia Phillies, Fife pitched 6.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits and three walks while striking out one. Fife left with a 2-1 lead and in line to get the win, but the Phillies rallied for two runs in the eighth to grab a 3-2 win. The right-hander held the Phillies' quartet of All-Star players Jimmy Rollins, Chase Utley, Ryan Howard, and Carlos Ruiz to a combined 1-for-11. Had his best outing of the season on July 6 vs. Round Rock, when he tossed 7.0 scoreless innings in which he allowed just two hits and two walks while striking out two in a 10-1 'Topes win. Won three straight decisions for the second time this season from May 30 to June 26, posting a 1.50 ERA (3 ER / 18.0 IP) in those starts. Had a shutout performance on May 30 in New Orleans when he tossed 6.0 scoreless frames, allowing seven hits and a walk while striking out five in a 4-0 'Topes win. In two starts at New Orleans this year, did not allow a run in 12.0 innings. Tossed 7.0 scoreless innings on May 4 vs. Nashville to extend his streak to 13.0 consecutive innings, fanning a season-high seven in an 8-1 'Topes win. Tied a franchise record by walking eight batters in just 4.2 innings on April 22 at Oklahoma City while allowing five runs on seven hits in an eventual 11-10 'Topes win 14 innings. The eight walks ties knuckleballer Charlie Haeger, who walked eight Omaha Royals in 4.2 innings on June 15, 2010. Enjoyed his first career Triple-A win on April 17 vs. Iowa when he pitched 5.2 innings in which he allowed six runs on 10 hits while walking one and striking out one in a 13-6 win. Also racked up two-hits, including a two-run double in the contest, becoming the first 'Topes pitcher to collect multiple hits in a game since Tim Redding went 2-for-3 on May 9 of last year vs. Memphis and the first to have more than one RBI since J.D. Durbin drove in three in a game vs. Round Rock on Sept. 1, 2009.

2011: Started the season with Double-A Portland (ME) in the Boston organization before he was traded to the Dodgers at the July 31 trade deadline in a four player deal that also sent Tim Federowicz and minor leaguer Juan Rodriguez to L.A. in exchange for Trayvon Robinson... overall, went 14-4 with a 3.74 ERA in 25 combined games (24 starts) with Double-A Chattanooga and Double-A Portland... set new career-bests in wins, innings pitched (137.0) and strikeouts (95)... posted a 3-0 record with a 4.01 ERA (15 ER / 33.2 IP) in six starts after joining Chattanooga... owned a 1-0 record with a 2.45 ERA in three road starts with the Lookouts... went 11-4 with a 3.66 ERA with the Sea Dogs before being traded to the Dodgers... at the time of the trade, his 11 wins were tops amongst all Red Sox farmhands... the 11 victories was tied for second-most in the Eastern League even though he played the last month in the Southern League... selected as a midseason Eastern League All-Star with Double-A Portland after tying for the league lead with 10 first half wins... named the Eastern League's Pitcher of the Week for the period of June 6-13... after taking a no-hitter into the seventh inning in his start on June 7 vs. Richmond... finished the game going 6.1 innings and allowing one hit while fanning seven... notched a career-high nine strikeouts in his July 5 start (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER) at Binghamton... did not allow an earned run in five of 18 starts with Portland... earned the victory in his first start after he was traded to the Dodgers organization, allowing just one run on two hits on August 5 at Jacksonville... following the season, pitched for the Salt River Rafters in the Arizona Fall League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In 2010, his first season with Double-A Portland, he paced the club in wins (8), starts (26), and innings (136.1) while finishing third on the team with 82 strikeouts... named to the Eastern League's midseason All-Star Team after going 5-2 with a 3.83 ERA before the break.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** Stephen J. Fife... played two seasons (2007-08) of college baseball at University of Utah and one at Everett Community College in Washington (2006)... went 7-5 with a 3.72 ERA in 15 starts for the University of Utah as a junior in 2008, leading the team in wins, starts, innings and strikeouts... played in the 1999 Little League World Series.
