ISOTOPES SURVIVE RENO RALLY FOR 7-5 WIN: The Albuquerque Isotopes got a sterling effort from Stephen Fife, two-run homers from Jerry Sands and Scott Van Slyke, and a clutch performance from the bullpen that staved off a late rally to claim a 7-5 win over the Reno Aces Saturday night at Aces Ballpark. A night removed from surrendering 22 runs, Isotopes pitching was in control thanks to Fife, who authored 7.0 superb frames, allowing just three runs on three hits while walking two and striking out one. The Isotopes jumped on the scoreboard in the bottom of the first when Sands smashed a monstrous two-run home run to left, making the score 2-0 Isotopes. Reno responded immediately in the bottom of the frame on a two-run homer by Mike Jacobs that knotted the game 2-2 and briefly grabbed a lead with a run in the bottom of the second on an RBI groundout that put the Aces on top 3-2. Albuquerque scored an equalizer in the top of the third and broke the stalemate in the top of the seventh, when Alex Castellanos put the Isotopes on top with an RBI triple and scored on a single by Sands to put the visitors on top 5-3. Van Slyke then mashed a two-run homer to left giving the Isotopes a four-run cushion at 7-3. Reno would not go quietly into the night, however, mounting a rally in the eighth to draw within 7-5, but the Isotopes escaped the threat and held on for a 7-5 win.

A BLAKE IN THE ROTATION: Righty Blake Johnson makes his fifth start of the season, but his first since he officially became a part of the rotation. In four previous starts, Johnson is a perfect 2-0 with a 5.21 ERA (11 ER / 19.0 IP) and should be 3-0 if not for an unprecedented rally in his last start. On August 6 vs. Tucson, Johnson allowed five runs on six hits in a seasonhigh 5.1 innings while walking one and striking out a season-high six. The right-hander left the game with a 10-2 lead, but the Padres mounted a late rally, scoring five in the six and seven in the eighth, to come up with a 14-11 win. Johnson is also perfect on the road, going 2-0 with a 2.57 ERA (4 ER / 14.0 IP) in six appearances, two starts, away from Isotopes Park.

WELCOME TONY: The Isotopes outfield is bolstered today with the arrival of Major League veteran Tony Gwynn, Jr., who joins the 'Topes after playing 103 games with the Dodgers, batting .232 (60x259) with eight doubles and 17 RBI. Gwynn led Los Angeles with four triples before he was Designated for Assignment on August 6. This will be Gwynn's first appearance in the Minor Leagues since 2009, when he batted .309 (47x152) in 38 games for Nashville prior to be traded to San Diego on May 21 and finishing that year with the Padres. Last year, Gwynn spent all season with the Dodgers, batting .256 (80x312) in a career-high 136 games, in which he racked up career-highs in doubles (12), RBI (22), stolen bases (22), and slugging percentage (.353).

SANDS KEEPS ON SLAMMING: A brief, four-day stay in Los Angeles has done little to cool off Jerry Sands, who continues to eviscerate Pacific Coast League pitching. Sands has racked up a hit in each of his last 12 PCL games, a streak that spans back to July 27. Over the course of the streak, Sands is batting .490 (25x51) but even more impressive is the slugger's power display. Sands has homered in three of his last four games and has belted seven long balls in his last 11 contests. Since the All-Star Break, Sands has driven in 31 runs, more than any other Pacific Coast League hitter.

HIT PARADE: Albuquerque has racked up double-digit hits in each of its last seven games, accumulating a total of 93 knocks (an average of 13.3 a game). As a result, the 'Topes have a team batting average over the month of August of .364, the highest in the PCL.

FIRST BLOOD: When the Isotopes manage to get on the scoreboard first, like they did last night, they usually prevail. Albuquerque is 39-17 when scoring first, the fourth-best record in the Pacific Coast League. When the opposition scores first, the 'Topes are 30-35.

NEXT HOMESTAND FAST APPROACHING: After a series in Reno and another in Colorado Springs, the Isotopes return home this Saturday for a quick four-game homestand against division rival New Orleans. In addition to being rife with playoff implications, the set includes fireworks, a green chile bobblehead giveaway, and 50-Cent Hot Dog Night!

TODAY'S START: Blake Johnson makes his fifth start of the season and the first since he officially joined the rotation. In his last start on August 6 vs. Tucson, Johnson pitched a season-high 5.1 innings, allowing five runs on six hits while walking one and striking out a season-high six. Left the game with a 10-2 lead, but the Padres rallied for a 14-11 win. Earned his third win of the season in the second game of a doubleheader at Nashville on July 29 after pitching 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits in an 11-0 'Topes thrashing of the Sounds. The right-hander got his first win of the season on July 21 vs. Iowa when he pitched 5.0 frames, allowing three runs on five hits while walking two and striking out three in a 16-3 'Topes thrashing of the Cubs. Four days later, Johnson picked up a win in relief on July 25 at Round Rock, pitching two perfect frames in a 6-5 Albuquerque win in 13 innings. Made his first start of the season in the second game of a doubleheader at Nashville on July 15, his first start since May 10, 2011 when he pitched for the Omaha Storm Chasers. Used exclusively as a reliever in his first 11 appearances for the Isotopes, the right-hander posted back-to-back scoreless appearances on July 6 and July 8 in which he tossed 2.0 frames without surrendering any hits while fanning two. Did not allow a ball to leave the yard in a five game stretch (5.1 IP) from June 26-July 8.

Promoted to Albuquerque on June 7 from Double-A Chattanooga, where he went 2-3 with a 3.38 ERA (11 ER / 29.1 IP) and one save in 21 relief appearances. Held opposing Southern League hitters to a .227 (25x110) batting average.

2011: Appeared in 43 combined games (one start), earning a 6-2 record with a 5.59 ERA in the Royals and Rockies organizations, transitioning to the bullpen full-time after making 131 starts in his previous six professional seasons... Gave up only six homers through 77.1 innings of combined work... totaled a 2-1 record with 7.62 ERA through 20 games (26.0 IP) with Colorado Springs... allowed two runs or less in 17 of 20 appearances with Sky Sox... posted a 3-1 record with one save in 30.1 frames with Omaha... made three consecutive appearances (8 IP) without allowing a run from May 24-31 for Storm Chasers... limited left-handed hitters to only five extra-base hits in 52 at-bats with Omaha... opened the season with Double-A Northwest Arkansas, picking up three saves and posting a 0.43 ERA (1 ER/21.0 IP)

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began the 2010 season with Northwest Arkansas, going 5-3 in 80.1 innings pitched over 23 games (10 starts)...also appeared in six games (one start) for Triple-A Omaha, allowing 1 ER or less in four of his six outings... tossed 51.1 innings with a 4-2 record and 2.63 ERA in second half of the season... pitched effectively against left-handed bats, limiting them to a .274 average with no triples or home runs, and 26 strikeouts to just eight walks... posted a 2-1 record with one save and 1.29 ERA (28.0 IP) in August, holding opposing sticks to .253 average.

Won eight games in 24 starts with Northwest Arkansas in 2009, ranking second on the team... his 4.57 ERA was second lowest among team pitchers with at least 81 innings of work, and his 122.0 frames ranked third among all Naturals... finished the season with 61 punch outs, third most on the team... tossed a one-hitter shutout through 6.0 innings in a win vs. Springfield on April 23... won three straight decisions from June 13-July 12... fanned a season-high seven through 6.1 innings on July 28 at Tulsa.

Spent entire 2008 season with Northwest Arkansas... tied for the team lead, and tied third in Texas League with 10 wins in 26 games (25 starts)... named to Texas League mid-season All-Star team... walked just 38 batters to 86 strikeouts in 143.0 innings of work... ranked third on the Naturals in innings pitched... hurled six innings or more in four consecutive starts from May 4-19, a span in which we went a perfect 3-0... had two spans where he won four straight decisions from May 4-25 and June 29-Aug-1.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Blake Wayne Johnson... Originally selected by the Dodgers in the second round of the 2004 First-Year Player Draft... graduated from Parkview Baptist High in Baton Rouge, La. ... was 8-3 with a 1.31 ERA in 12 games as a senior in 2004... struck out 116 batters, allowing just 15 walks and 39 hits in 64 innings
