ELY TIES FRANCHISE RECORD IN 5-3 'TOPES WIN: Starting pitcher John Ely earned a spot in the franchise record book by leading the Albuquerque Isotopes (71-52) to a 5-3 win over the Reno Aces (71-52) Monday night at Aces Ballpark. The right-hander secured his 13th win of the season, tying the team record set in 2008 by Frankie De La Cruz and tied in 2009 by Giancarlo Alvarado, after authoring six solid frames in which he allowed just two runs on three hits. In the fourth, Tyler Bortnick laced an RBI single to center, plating Mike Jacobs and moving Tyler Graham to third while giving the home team a 1-0 edge. Konrad Schmidt then dropped perfect a sacrifice bunt, sending home Graham and extending the Reno advantage to 2-0. Albuquerque would immediately roar back in the top of the fifth when Ivan De Jesus Jr. smashed a two-run double to center that instantly knotted the game at 2-2. Three batters later Scott Van Slyke drove a single to center, scoring De Jesus and giving the 'Topes their first lead at 3-2. Josh Fields and Josh Bard each hit RBI singles to widen the advantage to 5-2, 'Topes. A three run cushion was more than enough for Ely (13-7), who in addition to equaling a franchise record, tied the PCL high with his 13th victory. His six punchouts also helped Ely extend his domination in the PCL's strikeout department, bringing his total on the year to 142, 17 more than the next closest competitor. Like they have seemingly all series, the Aces attempted a comeback in the seventh when A.J. Pollock poked an RBI single to left, bringing the Aces within 5-3. Not a peep would be heard from the Aces the rest of the night as Michael Antonini and Erick Threets (4) secured a 5-3 Albuquerque win.

LOOP ON THE BUMP: Southpaw Derrick Loop toes the slab looking for his sixth win over his last seven decisions. Since transitioning to the Isotopes rotation, the lefty has posted a 4.50 ERA en route to a stellar 4-1 record. The Isotopes southpaw has also delivered quality starts in four of his last five outings, and allowed more than four runs just once through 29 appearances. In his most recent outing, a 7-2 win in the second game of a doubleheader against Tucson, the left-hander picked up his 10th victory of the season, marking the first time in franchise history the 'Topes have boasted three hurlers with double-digit wins. Loop turned in a superb effort to pick up the victory, allowing two runs on three hits in 6.0 innings of work.

TWO FOR THE SHOW: With last night's 5-3 victory of the Reno Aces, the 'Topes yet again prevailed in a two-run game, extending their record to a PCL-best 21-4 (.840) in contests decided by a pair of runs. Aside from their next closest competitor (New Orleans-21-10), no other club in the circuit has more than 13 wins in two-run games, and each of Albuquerque's last three games have been decided by two runs, a span in which the Isotopes went a perfect 3-0 by claiming wins of 5-3, 7-5 and 7-5.

ELY ETCHING HIMSELF IN THE RECORD BOOKS: Isotopes ace John Ely delivered another masterful performance in last night's start, as he continues to rank among PCL leaders in strikeouts (1st-152), wins (T-1st, 13) and ERA (T-2nd, 3.24). The right-hander's triumph also ties a franchise record for most wins in a season, originally set by Frankie De La Cruz in 2008 and tied by Giancarlo Alvarado during the 2009 campaign. Ely has been nearly unbeatable within the confines of The Lab, where his 8-2 mark is just one win shy of overtaking the team record for home victories. Not to be forgotten, Albuquerque's ace also tossed the team's first complete-game shutout of the season, allowing just six hits and a walk in 7.0 scoreless innings against Tucson on August 8

THE RUN PRODUCER: After driving in just seven runs from July 3-August 4, a span of 28 games, Ivan De Jesus Jr. has cranked up his offensive production to collect 10 RBI through his seven pre-

vious starts. This tear features four multi-RBI performances, including a three RBI night on August 8 against Tucson, and has been outmatched by only three other players in the PCL: Luis Antonio Jimenez (11 RBI), David Lough (11 RBI) and Mitch Maier (11 RBI). Dating back to August 5, the beginning of De Jesus Jr.'s hot-streak, the Isotopes infielder posts a .444 average with six extra-base hits

NEXT HOMESTAND FAST APPROACHING: After a series in Colorado Springs, the Isotopes return home this Saturday for a quick four-game homestand against division rival New Orleans. In addition to being rife with playoff implications, the set includes fireworks, a green chile bobblehead giveaway, and 50-Cent Hot Dog Night!

TODAY'S START: Derrick Loop takes the mound after becoming the third Isotopes pitcher to earn double-digit wins this season, steering the 'Topes to a 7-2 victory over Tucson in the second game of a twin-bill. The southpaw delivered his fourth quality start in his last five appearances in which he allowed just two runs on three hits through 6.0 frames, while fanning five and walking two. Saddled with the loss on Aug. 3 against Las Vegas, surrendering five runs on season-high eight hits in 6.0 innings of work. In the first game of a doubleheader at Nashville on July 29, Loop pitched 6.0 innings, allowing two runs in eight hits while walking one and striking out two in a game eventually won by the 'Topes in eight innings 4-2. Had his best start of the season even though it resulted in a no-decision on July 24 at Round Rock when he pitched a season-high 7.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits while walking one and striking out a season-high five. Loop didn't figure in the decision, however, as the Express won 5-4 in 11 innings. Made his first start of the season on June 28 at Memphis, his first since August 27, 2011, going 3.0 innings, giving up four runs on two hits and a season-high four walks while fanning two in a 10-8 'Topes win. Before moving to the rotation, made 20 appearances out of the bullpen, posting a 6-2 record with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER / 37.2 IP). Transferred to Albuquerque from Extended Spring on April 8 and made his Isotopes debut that night at Omaha, pitching 3.0 innings in which he allowed one unearned run. The outing marked just his second-career Triple-A appearance (he made one appearance for Lehigh Valley in 2010). Transferred to Ogden roster on April 11 but returned to Albuquerque for good on April 23. Pitched a then-season-high 4.0 innings in a win vs. Oklahoma City on May 28, the third in a string of three straight victorious decisions, also a season-high.

2011: Spent season between Single-A Clearwater and Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization... went 2-1 with a 1.13 ERA (4 ER / 32.0 IP) and three saves in 24 appearances for Clearwater.. left-handed hitters batted just .100 (4x40) against him, while righties batted .261 (18x69)... started the season by not allowing a run in his first 10 consecutive outings, a span of 12.1 conecutive scoreless innings... transferred to Reading on June 16 and finished the year there, going 1-3 with a 5.29 (20 ER / 34.0 IP) in 19 games (two starts)... held left-handed hitters to a 0.81 average (7x86)... made two starts to end the season (on August 17 and August 27), both in the second game of doubleheaders, and took the loss in both, going a combined 0-2 with a 5.63 ERA (5 ER / 8.0 IP)... his start on August 17 was his first since April 16, 2009, when he made the start for Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Started the 2010 season with Camden in the Independent Atlantic League, going 0-1 with a 1.72 (6 ER / 31.1 IP) in 33 games... walked just 17 batters while striking out 40... signed with the Phillies on July 14 and began season with Single-A Clearwater... was on DL, from August 15-22... did not allow an earned run in 14 of his 15 relief appearances with Clearwater before being promoted to Lehigh Valley on September 5 for his Triple-A debut... averaged 10.29 SO / 9.0 IP between both levels... held opponents to a combined .165 avg (15x91)... played for Aguilas in Dominican Winter League (16 G, 1-1, 2.79 ERA).

Spent majority of 2009 season with Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization, going 3-3 with a 1.61 ERA (12 ER / 67.0 IP) in 47 games (one start)... finished second in Boston system and third in Carolina League in saves with 18... ranked second in CL in ERA (1.61) and fouth in SO/IP (10.71)... selected as midseason Carolina League All-Star... had a 17.1-inning scoreless streak (nine games), April 12 to May 4, and a 21.2-inning scoreless streak (16 games), June 1 to July 27... did not allow an earned run in 40 of 47 appearances with Salem... promoted to Double-A Portland on August 24 and made four appearances for the Sea Dogs, going 1-0 with a 6.23 ERA (3 ER 4.1 IP).

In 2008, began season with Chico Outlaws of the independent Golden Baseball League, going 3-0 with a 1.53 ERA (5 ER / 29.1 IP) in six games (five starts)... had contract purchased by Boston and was assigned to Single-A Lancaster on June 25... set a Lancaster franchise record with 5 wins in August while posting a 1.64 ERA (6 ER / 33.0 IP) for the month... ended up 6-0 with a 3.04 ERA (18 ER / 53.1 IP) in 17 games (five starts) for Lancaster.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Derrick A. Loop... attended Norco High School in Norco, California before playing college baseball at California State University - Los Angeles.
