ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (71-53) AT COLORADO SPRINGS SKY SOX (65-59)

‘TOPES OUT-SLUGGED 12-9 BY SOX IN SERIES OPENER: After falling behind by five runs early, the Albuquerque Isotopes (71-53) valiantly rallied for a tie before ultimately succumbing to the Colorado Springs Sky Sox (65-59) in a 12-9 series-opening slugfest Tuesday night at Security Service Field. Albuquerque came out of the box fast, scoring four quick runs in the top of the first. Jerry Sands delivered a three-run triple to right, clearing the bags and putting the ‘Topes on top 3-0. Scott Van Slyke then roped a double to center, scoring Sands and extending the lead to 4-0, Isotopes. Colorado Springs answered immediately in the bottom half of the frame thanks to a two-run homer by Michael Cuddyer, before the home team erupted for six runs in the third that included a grand slam from Brandon Wood that put Colorado Springs ahead 7-4. Chad Tracy then added a double and scored on a double by Omir Santos, giving the Sky Sox an 8-4 cushion. After Colorado Springs added another run in the fourth on an RBI single by Wood to make it a five-run Sky Sox lead at 9-4, the Isotopes started mounting their comeback in the fifth. With Tim Federowicz on second and two down, pinch-hitter Tony Gwynn Jr laced a single to center, plating the runner and cutting the lead to 9-5. The ‘Topes kept rallying in the sixth when Van Slyke crushed his second double of the night, this one off the wall in left that plated De Jesus and cut the deficit to 9-6. Tyler Henson then followed with an two-run single to center, scampered to third on a base knock by Ozzie Martinez before racing home and tying the game 9-9 on a wild pitch. That’s where the rally would end, however, as the Sky Sox added three more in the bottom of the sixth on an RBI double by Cuddyer and run-scoring singles by Wood and Tracy to slug their way to a 12-9 win. Cuddyer finished his first of two scheduled rehab games with Colorado Springs a perfect 4-for-4 with a double, a homer, and three RBI. Meanwhile, Wood finished the game 3-for-6 with a team-high six RBI.

NIEVE NEEDING A WIN: Starter Fernando Nieve enters tonight’s contest having earned a loss and four no-decisions through his previous five outings, despite posting a solid 5.40 ERA. The righty is coming off his worst start since his season debut, having allowed nine runs, six earned, through 2.2 frames in a loss to Reno on August 10. However, excluding the tough outing against the Aces, Nieve has gone 1-0 with three quality starts since the All-Star Break, a stretch in which he has allowed two runs or fewer in four separate appearances. He was arguably the Isotopes’ most dominant hurler through July, posting a 2-0 record while ranking fifth in the PCL with a 2.71 ERA. With a victory tonight Nieve will pick up his first win since a July 13 triumph over Nashville.

DYNAMIC DUO: The imposing duo of utility men Jerry Sands and Scott Van Slyke has been a force to be reckoned with during the month of August. Through 13 games, the Isotopes have scored 89 runs with Sands and Van Slyke accounting for one-fourth of Albuquerque’s offensive production, totaling 10 and 12 runs respectively. The two ‘Topes have also driven in a combined 25 runs during the month, Sands with 14 and Van Slyke with 11, which is over 30 percent of the team’s total RBI in August. Both sluggers rank among PCL batting leaders through the 13-game stretch, as Sands paces the circuit with his .462 average and Van Slyke ranks sixth at .404.

SMOOTH SAILING FROM HERE: Albuquerque has typically struggled this season in the first game of four-game sets, and with defeats in each of their last four series openers (last night at Colorado Springs, 8/10 at Reno, 8/5 vs. Tucson and 8/1 vs. Las Vegas), the club posts a 15-17 record in game one against opponents. However, the ‘Topes have typically rallied in the final three contests, claiming a 55-35 (.611) mark through games two, three and four this year. The second contest of each series has been especially kind to the Isotopes as of late, with Albuquerque winning five of its last six game-two matchups.

IN A PINCH: With Tony Gwynn’s pinch-hit RBI single in the fifth inning last night, the Isotopes have now knocked an impressive five base hits in their last 11 pinch-hit at-bats (.455). Dating back to July 28, five different ‘Topes have factored into the five pinch-hits: Gwynn - RBI single on 8/14; Josh Bard - single on 8/10; Matt Angle - single, run scored on 8/8; Ozzie Martinez - single on 8/6; Tyler Henson - RBI single, run scored on 7/28. Thus far in the campaign, Isotopes pinch hitters are batting .267 (23x86).

NEXT HOMESTAND FAST APPROACHING: After a series in Colorado Springs, the Isotopes return home this Saturday for a quick four-game homestand against division rival New Orleans. In addition to being life with playoff implications, the set includes fireworks, a green chile bobblehead giveaway, and 50-Cent Hot Dog Night!

TODAY'S START: Fernando Nieve makes the start coming off a rough loss on August 10 when he gave up a season-high nine runs on ten hits through just 2.2 innings of work. Earned his fourth straight solid no-decision on August 4 when he worked 5.1 innings, allowing four runs on six hits while walking six and striking out five in a 6-4 'Topes win. Pitched 6.0 shutout innings on July 13 at Nashville, his second shutout performance of the season, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out six in a 7-0 'Topes win. The victory was his second in as many starts. Had his best outing of the season on June 8 vs. Memphis when he authored 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out two in a 12-0 'Topes win. Had an excellent outing on May 27 vs. Oklahoma City when he was pressed into service on three days rest when Michael Antonini was scratched and pitched 5.0 solid innings, allowing a run on three hits while walking one and striking out a season-high seven in an 11-9 win. Missed 15 days while on the Disabled List recovering from a hamstring strain. After 2.0 innings at New Orleans on April 26, Nieve came out to warm up for the third but could no further, leaving the game with a strained hamstring. The right-hander was placed on the DL the next day. Also had an outing on April 18 vs. Iowa at Isotopes Park that was truncated by an ejection. With two outs in the top of the third, Nieve hit Anthony Rizzo with a pitch and was immediately ejected by home plate umpire Mike Jarboe, ending the right-hander's day after 2.2 innings in which he allowed three runs on four hits while walking none and striking out three. Albuquerque went on to win the game 6-4. Enjoyed a terrific outing in the 'Topes' home opener on April 13 when he held the Omaha Storm Chasers to four runs, three earned, on seven hits in six strong innings of a 7-4 'Topes win. His start Isotopes Park debut stood in stark contrast to his season debut at Omaha on April 8, when he lasted just 1.2 innings, allowing nine runs on 11 hits while walking two and striking out two in a 17-11 'Topes loss.

2011: Spent a majority of the season pitching for the Doosan Bears in the Korean Baseball Organization... appeared in 25 games going 3-6 and a 6.09 ERA... finished the season tied for third on the team with six saves... also fanned 66 batters which ranked fourth amongst Bears pitchers... started the season with Triple-A Oklahoma City in the Houston organization where he made three starts for the RedHawks, going 1-2 with a 7.63 ERA (13 ER / 15.1 IP)... granted his release on April 27.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the majority of the 2010 season with New York (NL)... was Designated for Assignment on July 23rd and optioned to Triple-A Buffalo on July 27... made 40 appearances for New York and had one start, May 29 at Milwaukee, an 8-6 loss... in 2.0 innings, he gave up three hits, five runs, all earned, with three walks and five strikeouts... became the first pitcher in Mets franchise history to appear in 19 of the team's first 30 games... picked up victories in relief vs. the Cubs on April 19 (1.1 scoreless innings with one hit) and vs. Detroit at Citi Field on June 22 (2.1 innings, no hits, no runs, with a walk and four strikeouts)... in seven June games, went 1-0 with a 3.12 ERA (3 ER / 8.2 IP and eight hits)... worked a career-best 10.2 consecutive scoreless innings in nine appearances from April 17-May 3, giving up five hits, with three walks and 10 strikeouts... struck out a season-high four in 2.1 innings vs. Detroit on June 22... went a season-best 3.0 innings vs. Cincinnati on July 5, permitting one run on three hits... made eight straight starts for Buffalo upon his return to the Bisons... scored back-to-back victories against Scranton Wilkes-Barre on August 11 and against Pawtucket on August 16... went at least 6.0 innings in four of his eight Triple-A starts.

In 2009 went to Spring Training with Houston... was claimed off waivers by New York (NL) on March 13 and assigned to Double-A Binghamton... promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on May 18 and had his contract purchased by the Mets on June 5... placed on the 15-Day Disabled List on July 20 with a muscle tear in his right thigh and did not pitch for the rest of the season... tore the muscle during his start on July 19 at Atlanta... finished the season with the best ERA of his career (2.95)... Major League batters went hitless against him with runners in scoring position and two out (0-for-10)... made his Mets debut on June 6 with 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen in a 7-1 loss at Washington, allowing one hit and striking out two... beat St. Louis with 6.0 shutout innings on June 24 at home to establish a career-best three game winning streak... became the first Mets pitcher to win his first three starts with the team since Jorge Sosa in 2007... also tied his career-best scoreless streak with the 6.0 shutout innings on June 24.
