ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (72-53) AT COLORADO SPRINGS SKY SOX (65-60)

ISOTOPES SWAT SOX, 11-5: The Albuquerque Isotopes (72-53) scored runs in all but two innings, including tallies in six straight frames, to cruise to an 11-5 win over the Colorado Springs Sky Sox (65-60) on Wednesday night at Security Service Field. Trailing 1-0 in the second, Ivan De Jesus Jr. smashed a bases-loaded single to right, scoring two to give the 'Topes a 2-1 edge. Albuquerque added to the lead in the third on an RBI single by Jerry Sands and tacked on one more in the fourth when Matt Angle tripled and scored on a sacrifice fly by De Jesus to put the 'Topes ahead 4-1. Albuquerque tallied another run in the fifth thanks to an RBI single by Alex Castellanos. In the sixth, the 'Topes loaded the bases with no outs for Fernando Nieve, who smoked an RBI single up the middle, making the score 6-1. Angle then scored on a wild pitch, increasing the advantage to 7-1, and Gwynn hit a run-scoring fielder's choice that made it an 8-1 game. Colorado Springs scored two in the bottom of the sixth, but Sands blasted a solo home run in the seventh that put Albuquerque ahead 9-3. The Sox would then add a run in the bottom of the eighth, but the Isotopes scored two more in the ninth, one on an RBI single by De Jesus and another on a sac-fly from Angle to seize an 11-4 advantage. A solo homer by Brendan Harris in the bottom of the ninth did little to cause consternation for Albuquerque, who ultimately sailed to an 11-5 victory.

FIFE FINDING HIS GROOVE: Starter Stephen Fife takes the mound riding his third, three-game winning streak of the season. The right-hander was impressive in his last outing, limiting a powerful Reno lineup to three runs on a trio of hits through 7.0 innings of work, while walking two and fanning one. Before making his first relief appearance of the season on August 6, Fife was recalled to the Los Angeles Dodgers, making spot starts against the San Francisco Giants and Arizona Diamondbacks, in which he went a combined 0-1 through 10.2 innings while surrendering just three runs en route to a stellar 2.73 ERA. Facing the Iowa Cubs on July 22, the 'Topes righty struck out a season-high 12, only one shy of the franchise record. Fife has also won six of his last seven decisions and allowed three runs or fewer in each of his previous 11 appearances.

THE UNSTOPPABLE SANDMAN: With his solo shot in the seventh inning last night, Jerry Sands conintues his fantastic offensive streth at the plate, where he has mashed five home runs in his last eight games, boosting his season total to 24, third most in the PCL. The slugger has already smacked two walk-off dingers in 2012, and also posted three multi-homer performances, one of which tied league records for grand slams in a single game (2) and RBI in one contest (8). Along with his power at the plate, Sands has collected hits in 16 consecutive games, a streak that dates back to June 27 and includes a PCL-best .478 average (33x69). During that span, the Albuquerque outfielder has driven in an incredible 31 runs, 11 more than his closest competitor. As if that wasn't enough, the Isotopes own a 16-5 record when Sands blasts a homer during a game.

CAN YOU GIVE US SOME SPACE?: As the 2012 PCL playoffs rapidly approach, the Isotopes remain in a tightly contested battle for a playoff berth out of the American Southern Division. Both the Oklahoma City RedHawks (6.5 games back) and New Orleans Zephyrs (3.0 games back) are currently breathing down the 'Topes' necks, and although Albuquerque continues to string together wins, the Isotopes have never built a division lead of more than 4.0 games. With only 19 contests remaining in the regular season, upcoming series' against New Orleans and at Oklahoma City look to prove monumental in the 'Topes' potential playoff push. However, none of the three clubs have a leg up through their remaining schedule, as both the Isotopes' and Zephyrs' road to the playoffs include four-game sets against first place Omaha, while the RedHawks must face a red-hot Round Rock team that has won five contests in a row.

SEEING TRIPLE: Both Matt Angle and Josh Fields smashed triples against Colorado Springs last night, and along with Jerry Sands' three-bagger in the first game of the series, Albuquerque now has three triples over its last two games. This feat is roughly on par for the Isotopes' knack for three-baggers in 2012, as the 'Topes' lead all of Minor League Baseball with 52 triples. Albuquerque's closest competitors are

the Single-A Advanced Modesto Nuts, who's 50 three-baggers are still two shy of the Isotopes' total, while the Fresno Grizzlies (47) rank second in the PCL and trail by five triples. Leading the way for the 'Topes has been Trent Oeltjen (8), Alex Castellanos (7) and Elian Herrera (7), who rank seventh, eighth and ninth in the league respectively. Only three players on Albuquerque's active roster have yet to collect a triple this year, none of whom have appeared in more than 39 contests with the Isotopes in 2012: Josh Bard (39 games), Tony Gwynn Jr. (4 games) and Ozzie Martinez (23 games).

NEXT HOMESTAND FAST APPROACHING: After a series in Colorado Springs, the Isotopes return home this Saturday for a quick four-game homestand against division rival New Orleans. In addition to being rife with playoff implications, the set includes fireworks, a green chile bobblehead giveaway, and 50-Cent Hot Dog Night!

TODAY'S START: Stephen Fife gets the ball riding a three-game winning streak with his most recent victory coming against Reno on August 11, where he allowed three runs on just three hits through 7.0 frames while walking two and fanning one. Returned on August 6 from a brief stay with the Dodgers, with whom he made a pair of starts. Suffered his first big league defeat on August 1 vs. Arizona, when he pitched 4.1 innings, allowing two runs on six hits while walking three and striking out four in a 4-0 Dodgers loss. Had a solid no-decision at San Francisco on July 27, pitching 6.1 innings and allowing one run on six hits while walking three and striking out two in a 5-3 LA win in 10 innings. Fanned a season-high 12 on July 22 vs. Iowa, allowing one run on four hits in 7.0 innings in a 9-5 loss. Made his Major League debut with Los Angeles on July 17, when the right-hander filled in for an injured Chad Billingsley. Facing the Philadelphia Phillies, Fife pitched 6.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits and three walks while striking out one. Fife left with a 2-1 lead and in line to get the win, but the Phillies rallied for two runs in the eighth to grab a 3-2 win. The right-hander held the Phillies' quartet of All-Star players Jimmy Rollins, Chase Utley, Ryan Howard, and Carlos Ruiz to a combined 1-for-11. Had his best outing of the season on July 6 vs. Round Rock, when he tossed 7.0 scoreless innings in which he allowed just two hits and two walks while striking out two in a 10-1 'Topes win. Won three straight decisions for the second time this season from May 30 to June 26, posting a 1.50 ERA (3 ER / 18.0 IP) in those starts. Had a shutout performance on May 30 in New Orleans when he tossed 6.0 scoreless frames, allowing seven hits and a walk while striking out five in a 4-0 'Topes win. In two starts at New Orleans this year, did not allow a run in 12.0 innings. Tossed 7.0 scoreless innings on May 4 vs. Nashville to extend his streak to 13.0 consecutive innings, fanning a season-high seven in an 8-1 'Topes win. Tied a franchise record by walking eight batters in just 4.2 innings on April 22 at Oklahoma City while allowing five runs on seven hits in an eventual 11-10 'Topes win 14 innings. The eight walks ties knuckleballer Charlie Haeger, who walked eight Omaha Royals in 4.2 innings on June 15, 2010. Enjoyed his first career Triple-A win on April 17 vs. Iowa when he pitched 5.2 innings in which he allowed six runs on 10 hits while walking one and striking out one in a 13-6 win. Also racked up two-hits, including a two-run double in the contest, becoming the first 'Topes pitcher to collect multiple hits in a game since Tim Redding went 2-for-3 on May 9 of last year vs. Memphis and the first to have more than one RBI since J.D. Durbin drove in three in a game vs. Round Rock on Sept. 1, 2009.

2011: Started the season with Double-A Portland (ME) in the Boston organization before he was traded to the Dodgers at the July 31 trade deadline in a four player deal that also sent Tim Federowicz and minor leaguer Juan Rodriguez to L.A. in exchange for Trayvon Robinson... overall, went 14-4 with a 3.74 ERA in 25 combined games (24 starts) with $Double-A\ Chattanooga\ and\ Double-A\ Portland...\ set\ new\ career-bests\ in\ wins, innings$ pitched (137.0) and strikeouts (95)... posted a 3-0 record with a 4.01 ERA (15 ER / 33.2 IP) in six starts after joining Chattanooga... owned a 1-0 record with a 2.45 ERA in three road starts with the Lookouts... went 11-4 with a 3.66 ERA with the Sea Dogs before being traded to the Dodgers... at the time of the trade, his 11 wins were tops amongst all Red Sox farmhands... the 11 victories was tied for second-most in the Eastern League even though he played the last month in the Southern League... selected as a midseason Eastern League All-Star with Double-A Portland after tying for the league lead with 10 first half wins... named the Eastern League's Pitcher of the Week for the period of June 6-13... after taking a no-hitter into the seventh inning in his start on June 7 vs. Richmond... finished the game going 6.1 innings and allowing one hit while fanning seven... notched a career-high nine strikeouts in his July 5 start (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER) at Binghamton... did not allow an earned run in five of 18 starts with Portland... earned the victory in his first start after he was traded to the Dodgers organization, allowing just one run on two hits on August 5 at Jacksonville... following the season, pitched for the Salt River Rafters in the Arizona Fall

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In 2010, his first season with Double-A Portland, he paced the club in wins (8), starts (26), and innings (136.1) while finishing third on the team with 82 strikeouts... named to the Eastern League's midseason All-Star Team after going 5-2 with a 3.83 ERA before the break.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Stephen J. Fife... played two seasons (2007-08) of college baseball at University of Utah and one at Everett Community College in Washington (2006)... went 7-5 with a 3.72 ERA in 15 starts for the University of Utah as a junior in 2008, leading the team in wins, starts, innings and strikeouts... played in the 1999 Little League World Series.
