ISOTOPES DROP SERIES FINALE TO SKY SOX, 6-3: Jerry Sands extended his hitting streak to a season-high 18 games and Scott Van Slyke belted his 15th homer of the year, but it wasn't enough as the Albuquerque Isotopes were sunk by the Colorado Springs Sky Sox 6-3 on Friday night at Security Service Field. After the Sox jumped out to a 1-0 lead in the second, Albuquerque didn't wait long to respond, quickly taking a 2-1 lead in the third when Josh Fields poked a two-out single and Alex Castellanos coaxed a walk. Both runners then advanced on a double steal, setting the stage for Sands who promptly smoked a two-run single up the middle. The Sky Sox battled back in the fifth beginning with a leadoff single from Brendan Harris. Charlie Culberson followed with what appeared to be a double-play ball to short, but an errant throw by Ivan De Jesus Jr. on the force out allowed Harris to take third and the batter to settle at second. Wilkin Castillo then knotted the game 2-2 with a deep sac-fly and Brandon Roberts gave Colorado Springs a 3-2 edge on his pinch-hit RBI double. With a runner in scoring position, Tim Wheeler singled to right-center field to send Roberts to third, but as the ball bounced into the outfield Van Slyke misplayed the hop to allow the runner to dash home and make it 4-2, Sky Sox. After Colorado Springs added an insurance tally in the sixth and seventh to open up a 6-2 lead, Albuquerque flirted with a comeback when Van Slyke crushed a leadoff solo shot to left that narrowed the deficit 6-3, but three of the next four Isotopes were retired, ending the rally before any real damage was done and allowing the Sox to ultimately grab a series win.

ON THE CUSP OF RECORDS: Right-hander John Ely makes the start looking to possibly shatter two team records with one start. Currently, Ely is 13-7 on the year, tied for Isotopes record in wins in a season with Frankie De La Cruz (who did it in 2008), and Giancarlo Alvarado (who equaled the feat in 2009), meaning one more victory and Ely will hold the 'Topes record for wins in a season all by himself, while also moving into a tie with Las Vegas' Sean O'Sullivan for the PCL lead in victories. Ely is also tied with Alvarado in home wins with eight, so a win tonight would give him that record as well. The right-hander has won each of his last five starts, posting a 2.16 ERA (8 ER / 33.1 IP). He's also won each of his last three appearances at Isotopes Park.

IT'S A SHOWDOWN: The victor of the PCL's American Southern Division could very well be determined in the next four games at Isotopes Park, as the first-place 'Topes host the second-place New Orleans Zephyrs with just 2.0 games separating them. The last time the Z's visited The Lab, Albuquerque prevailed in a four-game series, dropping the first contest before rattling off three straight wins. Overall,

however, the season series has been perfectly even, with both teams winning six games against the other this year, which adds even more import to the set as the first tie-breaker in the PCL is head-to-head record. The Z's come in as the PCL's hottest team, posting a league-best 8-2 record in their last 10 games and having taken three of four from Sacramento, the PCL's best team. Of course, the Isotopes have Jerry Sands, who has driven in a team-high seven runs in 10 games against the Z's this season.

SENSATIONAL SANDS: John Ely is not the only Isotope to have a shot at a franchise record tonight, as Jerry Sands can equal the team's hitting streak record with a knock. With his two-run single last night, Sands has now hit in 18 straight games, one shy of the team record set by Eric Reed (2006), and equaled by Jamie Hoffmann (2010), and Elian Herrera (this year). Since the streak began on July 27, Sands is batting an incredible .443 (35x79) with 17 runs, two doubles, a triple, nine homers, and 33 RBI. In the course of just under three weeks, Sands has raised his average on the season from .260 to .298.

WELCOME BACK!: Tonight the 'Topes lineup will be bolstered by the arrival of Trent Oeltjen, who is back after spending the last 13 days in the DL with dizzy symptoms. Oeltjen went on the DL on August 7, retroactive to August 5.

OPENING JITTERS: The Isotopes have dropped each of their last four seriesopening games, with their last win in the first game of a series coming in Nashville on July 28. Overall, Albuquerque is 15-17 in the first game of a set this year.

THE 'TOPES ARE IN TOWN!: Tonight, the 'Topes are back for a quick fourgame homestand rife with playoff implications and awesome promotions. The set includes fireworks tonight, a green chile bobblehead giveaway tomorrow, and 50-Cent Hot Dog Night on Monday!

TODAY'S START: John Ely makes the start coming off his 13th win of the season, tying him for the franchise record with Frankie De La Cruz (who did it in 2008) and Giancarlo Alvarado (2009). On August 13 at Reno, Ely pitched 6.0 innings, allowing just two runs on three hits while walking three and strikin gout six in a 5-3 'Topes win. Delivered the first complete-game shutout by a 'Topes pitcher this season after limiting Tucson to just six hits through 7.0 innings while walking one and striking out eight in a 4-0 win in the first game of a doubleheader on August 8. The victory also tied him for the most home wins by an Isotopes pitcher in a season with eight, set in 2009 by Giancarlo Alvarado. Selected to his first Triple-A All-Star Game and his first since he appeared as a Southern League All-Star in 2009. Pitched a scoreless fourth inning, allowing one walk and striking out two in a 3-0 PCL win. Won a season-high fourth straight game after a victory on June 22 vs. New Orleans when he allowed four runs on five hits in 6.1 innings while walking one and striking out six in an 8-4 Isotopes win in seven-innings. Came two outs away from becoming the first Isotope this season to toss a complete game but surrendered back-to-back home runs that ended his night. Had a streak of six straight quality starts from April 30-May 26. Had a dominant 3-2 win at Tacoma on May 10 when he allowed just two runs on four hits while walking three and striking out a career-high 11, shattering his old career-high of nine set in 2008 when he was at Single-A Winston-Salem in the South Atlantic League. Authored 15.0 scoreless innings in three straight home starts from April 19-May 5. Earned his first victory of 2012, a stellar start on April 19 vs. Iowa when he allowed three runs on six hits in seven innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-3 'Topes win.

2011: Played most of the season in Albuquerque, going 7-8 with a 5.99 ERA (96 ER / 144.1 IP) in 25 starts.. recalled on April 10 and made a spot start for the Dodgers that day at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres... optioned back to Albuquerque on April 11... nearly threw his first career no-hitter and the first no-hitter in Isotopes history in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20... after holding the I-Cubs hitless going into the seventh and final inning, he struck out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith... then retired the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career... named PCL Pitcher of the Week for April 18-25 thanks to his performance... had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career... allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in the 3-1 'Topes victory... recalled on June 4 and had a brief stay with the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing of his career - 2007 at Rookie-Level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati... entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win... recalled one last time on Sept. 6 and made three more relief appearances for Dodgers, not allowing a run in 4.0 innings.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut in 2010, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL)... picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6-June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17-July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from Sept. 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodgers rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins.
