ELY SETS FRANCHISE RECORDS IN 3-1 'TOPES WIN: Starter John Ely set new franchise marks for both wins in a season and home victories as the Albuquerque Isotopes triumphed 3-1 over the New Orleans Zephyrs in front of a throng of 13,160 fans, the third largest crowd of the season, Saturday night at Isotopes Park. Ely pitched a gem, navigating 8.0 innings in which he allowed only one run on six hits to pick up his 14th win of the season, tied for most in the PCL. With the victory, Ely breaks the 'Topes franchise record for wins, while also surpassing the mark of eight home triumphs set during the 2009 campaign. The Isotopes' starter cruised through the first five innings before he was touched for his only run of the night in the sixth. With one out and two on, Luke Montz poked an RBI single to left, giving the Z's a 1-0 lead. Albuquerque quickly responded in the bottom half of the frame as Alex Castellanos and Jerry Sands collected back-to-back hits in front of a walk to Scott Van Slyke that loaded the bases. With the bases juiced, Tim Federowicz ripped a single to left that scored both runners to put the 'Topes up 2-1. Ozzie Martinez then gave the Isotopes an insurance run in the seventh when he singled to short and moved all the way to third on a wild pitch by New Orleans reliever Gary Glover. As Martinez dashed to third, Zephyrs catcher Hayes attempted to gun down the runner, but his errant throw went sailing into left field, allowing Martinez to cross home and pad the 'Topes' lead 3-1. After Ely retired the side in the eighth, Albuquerque closer Josh Wall took over in the ninth, coaxing three straight groundouts to pick up his PCL-best 24th save and preserve a 3-1 'Topes victory.

THIS ONE GOES TO 11: Lefty Derrick Loop takes the hill looking for his 11th win of the season while also continuing his recent dominance at Isotopes Park. Loop is 3-1 in four total starts at The Lab, a span in which he's posted a 3.52 ERA (9 ER / 23.0 IP). Overall, the lefty is 5-2 at Isotopes Park with a 4.43 ERA (20 ER / 40.2 IP) in 14 total appearances. Loop has pitched through the sixth in each of his last three starts at home, with two of those being quality starts. His 10 wins on the season is not only a career-high, it's one victory shy of the total number of triumphs he'd accrued over his last three seasons combined.

SANDS SENSING HISTORY: With John Ely already in the Isotopes record books with his exploits on the mound last night, Jerry Sands looks to join him today. With his broken-bat single left, Sands extended his current hitting streak to a franchise record 19 straight games, tying him with Eric Reed, who set the standard in 2006, Jamie Hoffmann, who tied the mark in 2010, and Elian Herrera, who equaled it earlier this season. During his streak, the slugger has batted .439 (36x82) with nine homers and 33 RBI. A hit today would not only make him

the first Isotope to reach 20 consecutive games, but would make him just the 12th player in the history of Triple-A baseball in Albuquerque to have a hitting streak reach 20 contests, tying him with Ross Jones (1983), Albuquerque Baseball Hall of Famer Joe Simpson (1978), and former Isotopes manager Tracy Woodson (1988).

HOME COOKING: Last night's win gave Albuquerque its 43rd victory at Isotopes Park, the most home wins in franchise history, surpassing the 42 triumphs the 'Topes racked up 2009. With a mark of 43-22, Albuquerque has the best home record in the PCL and its .661 winning percentage at The Lab is fifth-best in all of professional baseball among full-season clubs, behind only Winston-Salem (White Sox) of the Single-A Carolina League, (.687- 44-20), the Single-A St. Lucie Mets in the Florida State League (.683- 41-19), the Double-A Springfield Cardinals of the Texas League (.672- 41-20), and Lansing (Toronto) of the Single-A Midwest League (.667- 40-20). The best home winning percentage in the Major Leagues belongs to the Cincinnati Reds (.645- 40-22).

CATCHING Z'S: Albuquerque has won four straight against New Orleans, its longest winning streak against the Zephyrs since the Isotopes won four in a row from April 14-21, 2010. The 'Topes longest winning streak against the Z's is seven, set from April 25-May 11, 2009. True to form, the Isotopes and Zephyrs continue to play close contests. The average winning margin in 13 games played between the two teams is just 2.6 runs, with the largest margin of victory being just four tallies (both Albuquerque wins; 4-0 on May 30 at New Orleans; 8-4 7 inn. June 22 in Albuquerque.

TODAY'S START: Derrick Loop makes the start coming off a no-decision on August 14 at Colorado Springs when he lasted 4.0 innings, his shortest outing since his first start on June 28, allowing nine runs on eight hits while walking four and striking out two in a 12-9 'Topes loss. Became the third Isotopes pitcher to earn double-digit wins this season after steering the 'Topes to a 7-2 victory over Tucson in the second game of a twin-bill on August 9, allowing just two runs on three hits through 6.0 frames, while fanning five and walking two. Had his best start of the season even though it resulted in a no-decision on July 24 at Round Rock when he pitched a season-high 7.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits while walking one and striking out a season-high five. Loop didn't figure in the decision, however, as the Express won 5-4 in 11 innings. Made his first start of the season on June 28 at Memphis, his first since August 27, 2011, going 3.0 innings, giving up four runs on two hits and a season-high four walks while fanning two in a 10-8 'Topes win. Before moving to the rotation, made 20 appearances out of the bullpen, posting a 6-2 record with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER / 37.2 IP). Transferred to Albuquerque from Extended Spring on April 8 and made his Isotopes debut that night at Omaha, pitching 3.0 innings in which he allowed one unearned run. The outing marked just his second-career Triple-A appearance (he made one appearance for Lehigh Valley in 2010). Transferred to Ogden roster on April 11 but returned to Albuquerque for good on April 23. Pitched a then-

2011: Spent season between Single-A Clearwater and Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization... went 2-1 with a 1.13 ERA (4 ER / 32.0 IP) and three saves in 24 appearances for Clearwater. left-handed hitters batted just .100 (4x40) against him, while righties batted .261 (18x69)... started the season by not allowing a run in his first 10 consecutive outings, a span of 12.1 conecutive scoreless innings... transferred to Reading on June 16 and finished the year there, going 1-3 with a 5.29 (20 ER / 34.0 IP) in 19 games (two starts)... held left-handed hitters to a 0.81 average (7x86)... made two starts to end the season (on August 17 and August 27), both in the second game of doubleheaders, and took the loss in both, going a combined 0-2 with a 5.63 ERA (5 ER / 8.0 IP)... his start on August 17 was his first since April 16, 2009, when he made the start for Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization.

Spent majority of 2009 season with Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization, going 3-3 with a 1.61 ERA (12 ER / 67.0 IP) in 47 games (one start)... finished second in Boston system and third in Carolina League in saves with 18... ranked second in CL in ERA (1.61) and fouth in SO/IP (10.71)... selected as midseason Carolina League All-Star... had a 17.1-inning scoreless streak (nine games), April 12 to May 4, and a 21.2-inning scoreless streak (16 games), June 1 to July 27... did not allow an earned run in 40 of 47 appearances with Salem... promoted to Double-A Portland on August 24 and made four appearances for the Sea Dogs, going 1-0 with a 6.23 ERA (3 ER 4.1 IP).

In 2008, began season with Chico Outlaws of the independent Golden Baseball League, going 3-0 with a 1.53 ERA (5 ER / 29.1 IP) in six games (five starts)... had contract purchased by Boston and was assigned to Single-A Lancaster on June 25... set a Lancaster franchise record with 5 wins in August while posting a 1.64 ERA (6 ER / 33.0 IP) for the month... ended up 6-0 with a 3.04 ERA (18 ER / 53.1 IP) in 17 games (five starts) for Lancaster.
