ISOTOPES SLOPPY IN 7-6 LOSS TO LAS VEGAS: The Albuquerque Isotopes committed four errors, one shy of their season high, and allowed five unearned runs in a 7-6 loss to the Las Vegas 51s on Wednesday night at Isotopes Park. The Isotopes grabbed a quick 2-0 lead with a run in the first and another in the second, but Albuquerque would not be able to maintain its lead for long, as Las Vegas strung together a four-run fourth, largely thanks to three Isotopes errors. With runners on the corners and one out, Mark Sobolewski grounded to Alex Castellanos, who misplayed the ball, allowing one run to score and make it 2-1. Chris Woodward then poked a two-run single up the middle to plate the runner from second, and the play was extended as Scott Van Slyke bobbled the relay and sent an attempted throw to third sailing into left field. With the ball rolling into left, Sobolewski dashed home to put Las Vegas up 3-2, while Woodward came to rest at third. Ricardo Nanita capped off the big inning with a grounder to first that scored Woodward and widened the advantage 4-2. In the bottom half of the frame, the 'Topes cut the lead to 4-3 on an RBI double from Tim Federowicz, but Las Vegas would add three more in the sixth, extending its edge to 7-3. The Isotopes came storming back in the seventh on a solo shot from Angle that narrowed the deficit 7-4. Federowicz then smashed his third double in as many at-bats, advanced to third on a passed ball, and came home on a sac-fly from Trent Oeltjen to help Albuquerque climb within 7-5. Castellanos brought Albuquerque within one in the eighth, smashing a solo dinger to right that made it 7-6, but 51s reliever Jerry Gil came on in the ninth and retired three of the first four batters to slam the door on the Isotopes and preserve a one-run Las Vegas win.

THE ACE IS RIGHT AT HOME: Right-handed Isotopes ace John Ely makes the start riding a two-game winning streak that has vaulted him into a tie for the team-lead in victories with Will Savage with 10. As dominant as Ely has been overall, he's been superb at home, racking up a 6-2 record with a 2.99 ERA (23 ER / 69.1 IP) in 11 starts at Isotopes Park. One more win at home and Ely will have the most victories at The Lab by a 'Topes pitcher since Giancarlo Alvarado won a franchise-record eight games at home in 2009. Only three pitchers in team history have won seven games in Albuquerque (Michael Nannini, 2004; Ariel Prieto, 2005; Frankie De La Cruz, 2008). In his last two outings, Ely is 2-0 with a 1.35 ERA (2 ER / 13.1 IP) and in his last start at home, the right-hander held the Iowa Cubs to one unearned run on four hits in 7.1 innings while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 Isotopes win on July 23.

RARE ROUGH PATCH: Proving how dominant the Isotopes have been through the month of July, last night's defeat gave Albuquerque its first three-game losing streak since the 'Topes lost four in a row way back on June 29-July 2. Last night was also just their second loss at Isotopes Park in their last seven games. Even with the mini-skid, the Isotopes have not lost any ground in the PCL's American Southern Division. The 'Topes still hold a 1.5 game lead over Oklahoma City, as the RedHawks have lost four straight. Don't look now, but New Orleans is trying to make it a three horse race. Thanks to a seven-game winning streak, the Z's are now just 3.0 games behind the 'Topes.

FED DOUBLES DOWN: Last night, Tim Federowicz laced three doubles, tying a franchise record that's been achieved 13 previous times, the last by Luis Cruz on May 22 vs. Fresno. In his last seven home games, Federowicz has gone 9-for-26 (.346) with five doubles, a homer, and seven RBI. The 'Topes' All-Star catcher has driven in a run in seven of his last 10 games, accumulating a total of 10 RBI in that span.

ONE RUN WONDER: After dominating one-run games for most of the season, the Isotopes have had a tough time of late in the closest of games. Albuquerque has gone 1-5 in its last six games decided by a single run, dropping its record on the year to 18-15, the sixth-best winning percentage in such games in the PCL (.545). The 'Topes still pace the circuit in two-run games, going 17-3 (.850).

PACIFIC PORTS: With last night's setback, the Isotopes are 8-9 against teams from the Pacific Conference, but 3-6 against teams from the PCL's Pacific Southern

TODAY'S START: John Ely takes the mound coming off his team-high-tying 10th win of the season on July 28 at Nashville when he allowed just three runs, two earned, on six hits while walking none and striking out four in a 13-3 Isotopes win. Selected to his first Triple-A All-Star Game and his first since he appeared as a Southern League All-Star in 2009. Pitched a scoreless fourth inning, allowing one walk and striking out two in a 3-0 PCL win. Won a season-high fourth straight game after a victory on June 22 vs. New Orleans when he allowed four runs on five hits in 6.1 innings while walking one and striking out six in an 8-4 Isotopes win in seven-innings. Came two outs away from becoming the first Isotope this season to toss a complete game but surrendered back-to-back home runs that ended his night. Had a streak of six straight quality starts from April 30-May 26. Had a dominant 3-2 win at Tacoma on May 10 when he allowed just two runs on four hits while walking three and striking out a career-high 11, shattering his old career-high of nine set in 2008 when he was at Single-A Winston-Salem in the South Atlantic League. Authored 15.0 scoreless innings in three straight home starts from April 19-May 5. Earned his first victory of 2012, a stellar start on April 19 vs. Iowa when he allowed three runs on six hits in seven innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-3 'Topes win.

2011: Played most of the season in Albuquerque, going 7-8 with a 5.99 ERA (96 ER / 144.1 IP) in 25 starts.. recalled on April 10 and made a spot start for the Dodgers that day at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres... optioned back to Albuquerque on April 11... nearly threw his first career no-hitter and the first no-hitter in Isotopes history in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20... after holding the I-Cubs hitless going into the seventh and final inning, he struck out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith... then retired the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career... named PCL Pitcher of the Week for April 18-25 thanks to his performance... had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Elv's career. allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in the 3-1 'Topes victory... recalled on June 4 and had a brief stay with the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing of his career - 2007 at Rookie-Level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati... entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win... if he had worked the ninth, he would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA... optioned back to Albuquerque on June 6... had a short stay with the Dodgers after being recalled on August 1 and was inserted into the Los Angeles bullpen, but did not appear in any games before being optioned back to Albuquerque on August 7... recalled one last time on Sept. 6 and made three more relief appearances for Dodgers, not allowing a run in 4.0 innings.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut in 2010, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL)... picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6-June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17-July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from Sept. 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodgers rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins.
