SANDS SETS FRANCHISE RECORD IN 6-0 'TOPES WIN: Jerry Sands set a new team record with hits in 20 consecutive games, while three left-handed pitchers combined for a shutout as the Albuquerque Isotopes claimed a 6-0 win over the New Orleans Zephyrs Sunday afternoon at Isotopes Park. After a solo shot from Josh Fields in the bottom of the first gave the 'Topes a 1-0 lead, Alex Castellanos drew a walk, setting up Sands, who didn't wait long to make history. The slugger ripped a line drive down the left field line, becoming the first player in franchise history with base hits in 20 straight games. Following Sands' knock, Scott Van Slyke crushed a monstrous three-run shot to left that put the Isotopes ahead 4-0. Albuquerque added a tally in the third when Sands and Van Slyke both drew walks, followed by a single from Ivan De Jesus Jr. that scored Sands from second and widened the advantage 5-0. In the fourth, starter Derrick Loop broke his offensive slump, collecting his first base hit of the season and scoring on the next at-bat when Tony Gwynn Jr. launched a triple to right-center, making it 6-0 'Topes. Loop turned in a fantastic outing in which he tossed 6.2 scoreless innings, allowing just three hits while walking three and fanning four. Following Loop's departure, Albuquerque lefty relievers Scott Rice and Erick Threets authored 1.1 and 1.0 scoreless innings respectively, giving the Isotopes a 6-0 win

DON'T FORGET FERNANDO: Right-hander Fernando Nieve looks to keep Isotopes momentum rolling while also building off his sixth win of the season. On August 15 at Colorado Springs, Nieve allowed just three runs while scattering 10 hits, walking none, and striking out a season-high six in 5.1 innings of an 11-5 Isotopes win, their only victory in four games against the Sky Sox. Nieve, like his rotation counterparts John Ely, Stephen Fife, and Derrick Loop, is also demonstrably better at Isotopes Park than on the road. The right-hander is 4-3 with a 5.02 ERA (34 ER / 61.0 IP) in 12 games, 11 starts at home and 2-4 with a 7.06 ERA (34 ER / 43.1 IP) in 10 starts on the road. In his last four appearances at The Lab, Nieve is 1-0 with a 3.62 ERA (9 ER / 22.1 IP).

LOOKING FOR LUCKY 21: With his first inning base hit, Jerry Sands etched his name in the Isotopes record books by collecting a hit in a franchise-best 20 straight games. Since the streak began on July 27, Sands is batting a PCL-best. 440 (37x84) with 20 runs, two doubles, a triple, nine homers, and 33 RBI. Sands is now tied for the fourth longest streak in the Pacific Coast League this year, while shattering his previous career-high of 14 straight games with a base hit set when he was a member of the Single-A Great Lakes Loons in 2010. A hit tonight would give him the fifth-longest hitting streak in Albuquerque Triple-A history, moving him into a tie with Dukes

greats Pedro Guerrero (1977), Michael Huff (1989), Eric Karros (1991), and Jose Munoz (1993). The longest hitting streak in Dukes history is 31, set by Guerrero

AGENT ZEROS: Yesterday the left-handed trio of Derrick Loop, Scott Rice, and Erick Threets authored the eighth shutout thrown this season, tied for the most in one campaign in franchise history. In 2006 and 2009, the 'Topes pitching staff also delivered eight shutouts. Half of the shutouts by Albuquerque pitching this year has come at hitter-haven Isotopes Park, testament to how the well the staff has pitched in difficult environs.

BREATHING ROOM: Two straight wins over the Zephyrs has helped the 'Topes open up a 4.0 game lead on New Orleans in the PCL's American Southern Division, ensuring the Isotopes will leave for Memphis on Wednesday in first place. The four-game cushion is tied for Albuquerque's largest lead of the season and brings the Isotopes Magic Number down to 12. Oklahoma City is also hanging around, trailing by just 5.5 games.

DIVISION DOMINANCE: The Isotopes currently have a 25-17 record against foes from the PCL's American Southern Division with six more games vs. division rivals still to come (2 vs. N.O.; 4 at OKC). The Isotopes' best record in their division is 29-19, set in 2009 and equaled in 2010. After head-to-head record, the next tie-breaker is division record.

THE 'TOPES ARE IN TOWN!: Tonight, the 'Topes continue their quick fourgame homestand that is rife with playoff implications and awesome promotions. The set includes 50-Cent Hot Dog Night tonight and a Rally Hat giveaway to the first 3,000 fans courtesy of AARP tomorrow!

TODAY'S START: Fernando Nieve takes the mound coming off his fifth win of the season at Colorado Springs on August 15 when he allowed three runs on 10 hits in 5.1 innings while walking none and striking out six in an 11-5 'Topes win. Pitched 6.0 shutout innings on July 13 at Nashville, his second shutout performance of the season, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out six in a 7-0 'Topes win. The victory was his second in as many starts. Had his best outing of the season on June 8 vs. Memphis when he authored 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out two in a 12-0 'Topes win. Had an excellent outing on May 27 vs. Oklahoma City when he was pressed into service on three days rest when Michael Antonini was scratched and pitched 5.0 solid innings, allowing a run on three hits while walking one and striking out a season-high seven in an 11-9 win. Missed 15 days while on the Disabled List recovering from a hamstring strain. After 2.0 innings at New Orleans on April 26, Nieve came out to warm up for the third but could no further, leaving the game with a strained hamstring. The right-hander was placed on the DL the next day. Also had an outing on April 18 vs. Iowa at Isotopes Park that was truncated by an ejection. With two outs in the top of the third, Nieve hit Anthony Rizzo with a pitch and was immediately ejected by home plate umpire Mike Jarboe, ending the right-hander's day after 2.2 innings in which he allowed three runs on four hits while walking none and striking out three. Albuquerque went on to win the game 6-4. Enjoyed a terrific outing in the 'Topes' home opener on April 13 when he held the Omaha Storm Chasers to four runs, three earned, on seven hits in six strong innings of a 7-4 'Topes win. His start Isotopes Park debut stood in stark contrast to his season debut at Omaha on April 8, when he lasted just 1.2 innings, allowing nine runs on 11 hits while walking two and striking out two in a 17-11 'Topes loss.

2011: Spent a majority of the season pitching for the Doosan Bears in the Korean Baseball Organization... appeared in 25 games going 3-6 and a 6.09 ERA... finished the season tied for third on the team with six saves... also fanned 66 batters which ranked fourth amongst Bears pitchers... started the season with Triple-A Oklahoma City in the Houston organization where he made three starts for the RedHawks, going 1-2 with a 7.63 ERA (13 ER / 15.1 IP)... granted his release on April 27.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the majority of the 2010 season with New York (NL)... was Designated for Assignment on July 23rd and optioned to Triple-A Buffalo on July 27... made 40 appearances for New York and had one start, May 29 at Milwaukee, an 8-6 loss... in 2.0 innings, he gave up three hits, five runs, all earned, with three walks and five strikeouts... became the first pitcher in Mets franchise history to appear in 19 of the team's first 30 games... picked up victories in relief vs. the Cubs on April 19 (1.1 scoreless innings with one hit) and vs. Detroit at Citi Field on June 22 (2.1 innings, no hits, no runs, with a walk and four strikeouts)... in seven June games, went 1-0 with a 3.12 ERA (3 ER / 8.2 IP and eight hits)... worked a career-best 10.2 consecutive scoreless innings in nine appearances from April 17-May 3, giving up five hits, with three walks and 10 strikeouts... struck out a season-high four in 2.1 innings vs. Detroit on June 22... went a season-best 3.0 innings vs. Cincinnati on July 5, permitting one run on three hits... made eight straight starts for Buffalo upon his return to the Bisons... scored back-to-back victories against Scranton Wilkes-Barre on August 11 and against Pawtucket on August 16... went at least 6.0 innings in four of his eight Triple-A starts.

In 2009 went to Spring Training with Houston... was claimed off waivers by New York (NL) on March 13 and assigned to Double-A Binghamton... promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on May 18 and had his contract purchased by the Mets on June 5... placed on the 15-Day Disabled List on July 20 with a muscle tear in his right thigh and did not pitch for the rest of the season... tore the muscle during his start on July 19 at Atlanta... finished the season with the best ERA of his career (2.95)... Major League batters went hitless against him with runners in scoring position and two out (0-for-10)... made his Mets debut on June 6 with 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen in a 7-1 loss at Washington, allowing one hit and striking out two... beat St. Louis with 6.0 shutout innings on June 24 at home to establish a career-best three game winning streak... became the first Mets pitcher to win his first three starts with the team since Jorge Sosa in 2007... also tied his career-best scoreless streak with the 6.0 shutout innings on June 24.
