ELY RESILIENT IN 8-5 'TOPES WIN: Starter John Ely picked up his team-leading 11th win as the Albuquerque Isotopes broke a 4-4 tie in the sixth with a two-out, two-run rally that paced an 8-5 victory over the Las Vegas 51s on Thursday night at Isotopes Park. Ely, after allowing two quick runs in the first, settled down to retire 12 batters in a row from the second to the fourth inning. Through 7.0 frames of work, the right-hander held the visiting 51s to four runs while walking two and fanning four, extending his circuit-leading strikeout count to 138. Trailing 2-0, Albuquerque immediately responded in the bottom half of the first when Trent Oeltjen poked a leadoff single and scored on a triple from Ivan De Jesus Jr. to cut the deficit 2-1. Alex Castellanos followed with an RBI double that plated De Jesus Jr., and three batters later Josh Fields slapped an RBI single that gave the 'Topes a 3-2 advantage. The Isotopes added a run in the fifth to take a 4-2 lead, but the 51s knotted the game with a two-run homer from Danny Perales in the top of the sixth. With the contest knotted 4-4, the Isotopes surged ahead when Jerry Sands belted a two-run double to center that gave Albuquerque a 6-4 edge. The 'Topes padded their cushion with two more in the eighth to go up 8-4, plenty of room of room to withstand a small Las Vegas rally in the ninth and claim the 8-5 victory.

DERRICK AND THE DOMINOES: Lefty Derrick Loop makes the start coming off back-to-back no-decisions in which he's pitched extremely well. After tossing a season-high 7.0 innings on July 24 in Round Rock, giving up a run on five hits while walking one and striking out five in a 5-4 11-inning loss, the southpaw worked another six solid frames in his next start at Nashville in the first game of a doubleheader on July 29. Loop departed after 6.0 innings in which he gave up two runs on eight hits while walking one and striking out two but for the second straight start, the southpaw left with the game tied and watched as the game went into the extra-innings, the 'Topes ultimately prevailing 4-2 in 8 frames. As such, Loop's four-game winning streak, which dates back to June 21, remains intact and in his last three starts the left-hander has posted a 1.89 ERA (4 ER / 19.0 IP).

THE PRODUCER: In his last seven games, Jerry Sands has driven in a remarkable 18 runs, 36% of all the runs scored by the Isotopes (50) in that span. To say Sands is hot would be the understatement of the week, as the outfielder has hit in eight straight games, batting .454 (15x33) with two doubles and four homers since July 27. Sands' hot streak really goes back about a month, as he's gotten a hit in 22 of the last 25 games he's played, batting .366 (34x93) with 15 runs, four doubles, eight homers, and 29 RBI since July 5.

ALL IN ALL IT'S JUST ANOTHER SAVE FOR THE WALL: Last night, Josh Wall recorded his 20th save of the season, surging ahead of Fresno's Jonathan Albaldejo for the Pacific Coast League lead. With 31 games to go in the regular season, Wall already has the fourth most saves by an Isotope in a single season, trailing only Scott Strickland (32 in 2009), Brad Clontz (23 in 2006), and Blaine Neal (21 in 2003). In 22 total save opportunities, Wall has failed to record a save on just two occa-

HOME COOKIN': Last night's victory was the 'Topes' 11th win out of their last 15 games played at Isotopes Park. It also extended Albuquerque's streak of avoiding back-to-back defeats at home. In 58 total games played in the Duke City, the Isotopes have been defeated two times in row just three times (May 19-20 vs. Sacramento; May 23-24 vs. Fresno; June 12-13 vs. Round Rock). As you'd expect, with a mark of 39-19, the Isotopes have the best home record in the Pacific Coast League.

IT'S FRIDAY, FRIDAY: Like most of us working stiffs, the Isotopes look forward to Friday more than any other day of the week. Albuquerque has a record of 11-6 in games played on Friday night. Of course, the 'Topes are strong throughout the weekend, going 32-20 on Friday, Saturday and Sunday while amassing a record of 33-28 the rest of the week.

TODAY'S START: Derrick Loop takes the mound riding a season-high four-game winning streak and coming off a second straight no-decision in which he pitched well. In the first game of a doubleheader at Nashville on July 29, Loop pitched 6.0 innings, allowing two runs in eight hits while walking one and striking out two in a game eventually won by the 'Topes in eight innings 4-2. Had his best start of the season even though it resulted in a no-decision on July 24 at Round Rock when he pitched a season-high 7.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits while walking one and striking out a season-high five. Loop didn't figure in the decision, however, as the Express won 5-4 in 11 innings. Made his first start of the season on June 28 at Memphis, his first since August 27, 2011, going 3.0 innings, giving up four runs on two hits and a season-high four walks while fanning two in a 10-8 'Topes win. Before moving to the rotation, made 20 appearances out of the bullpen, posting a 6-2 record with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER / 37.2 IP). Transferred to Albuquerque from Extended Spring on April 8 and made his Isotopes debut that night at Omaha, pitching 3.0 innings in which he allowed one unearned run. The outing marked just his secondcareer Triple-A appearance (he made one appearance for Lehigh Valley in 2010). Transferred to Ogden roster on April 11 but returned to Albuquerque for good on April 23. Pitched a then-season-high 4.0 innings in a win vs. Oklahoma City on May 28, the third in a string of three straight victorious decisions, also a season-high.

2011: Spent season between Single-A Clearwater and Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization... went 2-1 with a 1.13 ERA (4 ER / 32.0 IP) and three saves in 24 appearances for Clearwater.. left-handed hitters batted just .100 (4x40) against him, while righties batted .261 (18x69)... started the season by not allowing a run in his first 10 consecutive outings, a span of 12.1 conecutive scoreless innings... transferred to Reading on June 16 and finished the year there, going 1-3 with a 5.29 (20 ER / 34.0 IP) in 19 games (two starts)... held lefthanded hitters to a 0.81 average (7x86)... made two starts to end the season (on August 17 and August 27), both in the second game of doubleheaders, and took the loss in both, going a combined 0-2 with a 5.63 ERA (5 ER / 8.0 IP)... his start on August 17 was his first since April 16, 2009, when he made the start for Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Started the 2010 season with Camden in the Independent Atlantic League, going 0-1 with a 1.72 (6 ER / 31.1 IP) in 33 games... walked just 17 batters while striking out 40... signed with the Phillies on July 14 and began season with Single-A Clearwater... was on DL, from August 15-22... did not allow an earned run in 14 of his 15 relief appearances with Clearwater before being promoted to Lehigh Valley on September 5 for his Triple-A debut... averaged 10.29 SO / 9.0 IP between both levels... held opponents to a combined .165 avg (15x91)... played for Aguilas in Dominican Winter League (16 G, 1-1, 2.79 ERA).

Spent majority of 2009 season with Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization, going 3-3 with a 1.61 ERA (12 ER / 67.0 IP) in 47 games (one start)... finished second in Boston system and third in Carolina League in saves with 18... ranked second in CL in ERA (1.61) and fouth in SO/IP (10.71)... selected as midseason Carolina League All-Star... had a 17.1-inning scoreless streak (nine games), April 12 to May 4, and a 21.2-inning scoreless streak (16 games), June 1 to July 27... did not allow an earned run in 40 of 47 appearances with Salem... promoted to Double-A Portland on August 24 and made four appearances for the Sea Dogs, going 1-0 with a 6.23 ERA (3 ER 4.1 IP).

In 2008, began season with Chico Outlaws of the independent Golden Baseball League, going 3-0 with a 1.53 ERA (5 ER / 29.1 IP) in six games (five starts)... had contract purchased by Boston and was assigned to Single-A Lancaster on June 25... set a Lancaster franchise record with 5 wins in August while posting a 1.64 ERA (6 ER / 33.0 IP) for the month... ended up 6-0 with a 3.04 ERA (18 ER / 53.1 IP) in 17 games (five starts) for Lancaster.
