ALBUQUERQUE DOWNED BY LAS VEGAS 6-3: The Albuquerque Isotopes fell victim to a four RBI night from Mike McDade, three of which came on a home run in the fourth, that ultimately spelled the difference in a 6-3 loss to the Las Vegas 51s on Friday night at Isotopes Park. Albuquerque drew first blood in the second when Jerry Sands smacked his fifth homer in his last eight games, a solo shot, that put the home team up 1-0. Las Vegas answered quickly in the next frame as Tuffy Gosewisch belted a one-out double to right and advanced to third on a single from Mike McCoy. Adeiny Hechavarria then ripped an RBI single to left that plated Gosewisch and tied the contest 1-1. With two outs and two runners on, McDade blasted a three-run homer to center that capped Las Vegas' rally and put the visitors up 4-1. The 51s would score once more in the fourth on an RBI single from McCoy, before the 'Topes mounted a small comeback in the fifth. Scott Van Slyke got things rolling for the Isotopes with a leadoff solo dinger to left, cutting the deficit 5-2. Tim Federowicz followed with a single to third, advanced to second on a walk to Josh Bard and took third on a flyout from Tyler Henson. Matt Angle then brought Federowicz home with an RBI single to right that narrowed Las Vegas' lead to 5-3. The "visitors" added an insurance run in the ninth to make it 6-3 and the three-run advantage would prove too much for Albuquerque, who fell 6-3.

ONE HOT PITCHER: Since July 1, one of the hottest pitchers in the entire Pacific Coast League is none other than Isotopes right-hander Fernando Nieve. In his last five starts, Nieve has posted an ERA of 2.17 (7 ER / 29.0 IP), third lowest among all PCL starts in that span. Although he's 2-0 over his hot spell, the right-hander is coming off three straight no-decisions in which he's been solid, posting a 2.65 ERA (5 ER / 17.0 IP). Indicative of Nieve's success is his walk to strikeout ratio. Since July 1, the right-hander has fanned 30 batters, including a season-high eight in his last outing, while walking just eight.

SERIES THINKING: Today the 'Topes will look to avoid their first home series loss since way back on June 11-13, when Albuquerque dropped two of three to the Round Rock Express. The only time the Isotopes have dropped a four-game home series this year was on May 17-20 when Sacramento came into The Lab and snagged three games. In franchise history, the 'Topes have never lost a series at home to the Las Vegas 51s, sweeping two sets and splitting another two. This year, the Isotopes have won nine series, lost two, and split three.

HOMER HAPPY: Since the All-Star Break, 'Topes slugger Jerry Sands has blasted eight home runs, tied for the most in the PCL with Round Rock's Brad Nelson. Since July 12, Sands has also driven in 26 runs, second most in the league, over 22 games. Sands has racked up a hit in each of his last nine games, batting .432 (16x37) with six runs, two doubles, five homers, and 19 RBI

STANDING PAT: Like a well-orchestrated tango, the Isotopes and their division nemesis the Oklahoma City RedHawks have been moving without going anywhere. On July 29, the 'Topes took a 1.5 game lead in the PCL's American Southern Division and have remained a game and a half ahead for six straight days.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY X 3: Today begins a stretch of three straight days in which an Isotope will be celebrating his birthday. First up is Alex Castellanos, who is celebrating his 26th birthday today! Tomorrow, Tim Federowicz turns 25 and on Monday, Michael Antonini celebrates his 27th. In fact, given the last two weeks.

don't be surprised if there's a shortage of birthday candles around The Lab. Since July 24, three other Isotopes have celebrated birthdays, Scott Van Slyke (July 24), Cole St. Clair (July 30), and 'Topes GM John Traub (August 1).

TODAY'S START: Fernando Nieve makes the start coming off his third straight solid no-decision on July 30 at Nashville when he worked 7.0 innings, allowing three runs, two earned, on four hits while walking one and striking out a season-high eight in an eventual 4-3 'Topes loss. Pitched 6.0 shutout innings on July 13 at Nashville, his second shutout performance of the season, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out six in a 7-0 'Topes win. The victory was his second in as many starts. Had his best outing of the season on June 8 vs. Memphis when he authored 7.0 shutout innings. allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out two in a 12-0 'Topes win. Had an excellent outing on May 27 vs. Oklahoma City when he was pressed into service on three days rest when Michael Antonini was scratched and pitched 5.0 solid innings, allowing a run on three hits while walking one and striking out a season-high seven in an 11-9 win. Missed 15 days while on the Disabled List recovering from a hamstring strain. After 2.0 innings at New Orleans on April 26, Nieve came out to warm up for the third but could no further, leaving the game with a strained hamstring. The right-hander was placed on the DL the next day. Also had an outing on April 18 vs. Iowa at Isotopes Park that was truncated by an ejection. With two outs in the top of the third, Nieve hit Anthony Rizzo with a pitch and was immediately ejected by home plate umpire Mike Jarboe, ending the right-hander's day after 2.2 innings in which he allowed three runs on four hits while walking none and striking out three. Albuquerque went on to win the game 6-4. Enjoyed a terrific outing in the 'Topes' home opener on April 13 when he held the Omaha Storm Chasers to four runs, three earned, on seven hits in six strong innings of a 7-4 'Topes win. His start Isotopes Park debut stood in stark contrast to his season debut at Omaha on April 8, when he lasted just 1.2 innings, allowing nine runs on 11 hits while walking two and striking out two in a 17-11 'Topes loss.

2011: Spent a majority of the season pitching for the Doosan Bears in the Korean Baseball Organization... appeared in 25 games going 3-6 and a 6.09 ERA... finished the season tied for third on the team with six saves... also fanned 66 batters which ranked fourth amongst Bears pitchers... started the season with Triple-A Oklahoma City in the Houston organization where he made three starts for the RedHawks, going 1-2 with a 7.63 ERA (13 ER / 15.1 IP)... granted his release on April 27.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the majority of the 2010 season with New York (NL)... was Designated for Assignment on July 23rd and optioned to Triple-A Buffalo on July 27... made 40 appearances for New York and had one start, May 29 at Milwaukee, an 8-6 loss... in 2.0 innings, he gave up three hits, five runs, all earned, with three walks and five strikeouts... became the first pitcher in Mets franchise history to appear in 19 of the team's first 30 games... picked up victories in relief vs. the Cubs on April 19 (1.1 scoreless innings with one hit) and vs. Detroit at Citi Field on June 22 (2.1 innings, no hits, no runs, with a walk and four strikeouts)... in seven June games, went 1-0 with a $3.12\ ERA$ (3 ER / $8.2\ IP$ and eight hits)... worked a career-best 10.2 consecutive scoreless innings in nine appearances from April 17-May 3, giving up five hits, with three walks and 10 strikeouts... struck out a season-high four in 2.1 innings vs. Detroit on June 22... went a season-best 3.0 innings vs. Cincinnati on July 5, permitting one run on three hits... made eight straight starts for Buffalo upon his return to the Bisons... scored backto-back victories against Scranton Wilkes-Barre on August 11 and against Pawtucket on August 16... went at least 6.0 innings in four of his eight Triple-A starts.

In 2009 went to Spring Training with Houston... was claimed off waivers by New York (NL) on March 13 and assigned to Double-A Binghamton... promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on May 18 and had his contract purchased by the Mets on June 5... placed on the 15-Day Disabled List on July 20 with a muscle tear in his right thigh and did not pitch for the rest of the season... tore the muscle during his start on July 19 at Atlanta... finished the season with the best ERA of his career (2.95)... Major League batters went hitless against him with runners in scoring position and two out (0-for-10)... made his Mets debut on June 6 with 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen in a 7-1 loss at Washington, allowing one hit and striking out two... beat St. Louis with 6.0 shutout innings on June 24 at home to establish a career-best three game winning streak... became the first Mets pitcher to win his first three starts with the team since Jorge Sosa in 2007... also tied his career-best scoreless streak with the 6.0 shutout innings on June 24.
