## TUCSON PADRES (45-70) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (66-50)

ISOTOPES COMEBACK FALLS SHORT IN 10-8 LOSS: Ivan De Jesus Jr. finished a triple short of the cycle, but it was not enough as the Albuquerque Isotopes allowed seven runs in the fourth inning, tying a season high for most tallies in one frame, and could never recover in a 10-8 loss to the Tucson Padres on Sunday night at Isotopes Park. Tucson opened up a 1-0 lead in the second on an RBI single from Beamer Weems, but the 'Topes immediately responded in the bottom half of the frame. Scott Van Slyke began the rally with a leadoff double and scored two batters later on a two-run blast from De Jesus Jr. that gave the Isotopes a 2-1 edge. The Padres then blew the game wide open with a seven-run fourth, beginning with an RBI single by Sawyer Carroll that tied the game. With two runners on, Weems crushed a three-run dinger that put Tucson up 5-2. Anthony Contreras then ripped an RBI single that made it 6-2 before an RBI single and a sac-fly capped the frame and gave the Padres an 8-2 lead. The visitors would add two more in the fifth before Albuquerque scored in three consecutive innings to make it interesting. With the score 10-6, the Isotopes flirted with a comeback in the bottom of ninth as Matt Angle roped a leadoff double to left and took third on a flyout from Elian Herrera. After Ozzie Martinez coaxed a one-out walk, Josh Fields grounded into a force out that plated Angle and trimmed the Padres' lead to 10-7. Van Slyke followed with an RBI double, bringing the 'Topes within 10-8, but Tucson reliever Neil Wagner fanned the final Albuquerque batter, preserving a 10-8 T-Pads win.

A PERFECT STARTER: Right-hander reliever Blake Johnson makes the spot start riding a stretch in which he's been perfect when pressed into a starting role. Over the last two times he's made a spot-start, Johnson is 2-0 with a sparkling 2.70 ERA (3 ER / 10.0 IP). Even considering his first start of the season, when he took a no-decision, Johnson has a 3.95 ERA (6 ER / 13.2 IP) in three total starts this year. The last time he joined the rotation, Johnson turned in a beauty, pitching 5.0 shutout innings in the second game of a doubleheader at Nashville on July 29 in which he allowed just two hits but ended up getting overshadowed by the exploits of Jerry Sands, who belted two grand slam homers to propel Albuquerque to an 11-0 win. Johnson will be followed tonight by starter Stephen Fife, who rejoins the 'Topes after a second stint in L.A. with the Dodgers. Fife made the start for Los Angeles on August 1 but hasn't pitched since, so the right-hander will be utilized in relief of Johnson to get some work in.

CONGRATS JERRY!: The blistering tear of Jerry Sands has captured the attention of the Dodgers, who today recalled the red-hot slugger. Sands had collected hits in each of his last 10 games, batting .476 (20x42) with seven runs, two doubles, six homers, and 21 RBI. Since the All-Star Break, Sands leads the PCL with nine homers and a .733 slugging percentage. This will be Sands' second trip to Los Angeles this season, having appeared in eight games for the Dodgers from May 15-27 in which he batted .200 (4x20). To make room for Sands on the roster, the Dodger designated outfielder Tony Gwynn Jr. for assignment.

ES FUEGO EN AUGUSTO: It must be August, because Ivan De Jesus Jr. is starting to heat up at the plate. In five games played so far in August, De Jesus is 7-for-16 (.438) including a season-high 4-for-4 last night in which he came a triple away from the cycle. Then again, this is nothing new for the infielder, who had his best month last year in August, batting .333 in 29 games with six of his eight total home runs. De Jesus has hit a total 17 home runs in an Isotopes uniform from 2010 to this year, with nine of those coming in the month of August.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY ANTONINI!:** Happy 27th birthday to 'Topes lefty reliever Michael Antonini. The pitcher is the last of three Isotopes to celebrate birthdays on consecutive days. Alex Castellanos had a birthday on Saturday, while Tim Federowicz turned 25 yesterday.

**SECOND HEAVEN:** If history is any indication, Albuquerque can go ahead and chalk up a win tonight. The Isotopes this year are an incredible 22-7 in the second game of a series, with their last loss coming on July 17 vs. Memphis.

**BONUS FIREWORKS!:** Fan Appreciation Weekend gets even more exciting as the Isotopes are adding a fireworks show on August 31, setting up a stretch of three straight nights (August 31-Sept. 2) with post-game pyrotechnics. The August 31 spectacular is sponsored by Mark's CASA Chevrolet.

TODAY'S START: Blake Johnson makes his fourth spot-start of the season coming off an ining of scoreless relief work on August 3 vs. Las Vegas. In the last start, in the second game of a doubleheader at Nashville, Johnson earned his third win of the season after pitching 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits in an 11-0 'Topes thrashing of the Sounds. The right-hander got his first win of the season on July 21 vs. Iowa when he pitched 5.0 frames, allowing three runs on five hits while walking two and striking out three in a 16-3 'Topes thrashing of the Cubs. Four days later, Johnson picked up a win in relief on July 25 at Round Rock, pitching two perfect frames in a 6-5 Albuquerque win in 13 innings. Made his first start of the season in the second game of a doubleheader at Nashville on July 15, his first start since May 10, 2011 when he pitched for the Omaha Storm Chasers. Used exclusively as a reliever in his first 11 appearances for the Isotopes, the right-hander posted back-to-back scoreless appearances on July 6 and July 8 in which he tossed 2.0 frames without surrendering any hits while fanning two. Did not allow a ball to leave the yard in a five game stretch (5.1 IP) from June 26-July 8.

Promoted to Albuquerque on June 7 from Double-A Chattanooga, where he went 2-3 with a 3.38 ERA (11 ER / 29.1 IP) and one save in 21 relief appearances. Held opposing Southern League hitters to a .227 (25x110) batting average.

2011: Appeared in 43 combined games (one start), earning a 6-2 record with a 5.59 ERA in the Royals and Rockies organizations, transitioning to the bullpen full-time after making 131 starts in his previous six professional seasons... Gave up only six homers through 77.1 innings of combined work... totaled a 2-1 record with 7.62 ERA through 20 games (26.0 IP) with Colorado Springs... allowed two runs or less in 17 of 20 appearances with Sky Sox... posted a 3-1 record with one save in 30.1 frames with Omaha... made three consecutive appearances (8 IP) without allowing a run from May 24-31 for Storm Chasers... limited left-handed hitters to only five extra-base hits in 52 at-bats with Omaha... opened the season with Double-A Northwest Arkansas, picking up three saves and posting a 0.43 ERA (1 ER/21.0 IP)

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began the 2010 season with Northwest Arkansas, going 5-3 in 80.1 innings pitched over 23 games (10 starts)...also appeared in six games (one start) for Triple-A Omaha, allowing 1 ER or less in four of his six outings... tossed 51.1 innings with a 4-2 record and 2.63 ERA in second half of the season... pitched effectively against left-handed bats, limiting them to a .274 average with no triples or home runs, and 26 strikeouts to just eight walks... posted a 2-1 record with one save and 1.29 ERA (28.0 IP) in August, holding opposing sticks to .253 average.

Won eight games in 24 starts with Northwest Arkansas in 2009, ranking second on the team... his 4.57 ERA was second lowest among team pitchers with at least 81 innings of work, and his 122.0 frames ranked third among all Naturals... finished the season with 61 punch outs, third most on the team... tossed a one-hitter shutout through 6.0 innings in a win vs. Springfield on April 23... won three straight decisions from June 13-July 12... fanned a season-high seven through 6.1 innings on July 28 at Tulsa.

Spent entire 2008 season with Northwest Arkansas... tied for the team lead, and tied third in Texas League with 10 wins in 26 games (25 starts)... named to Texas League mid-season All-Star team... walked just 38 batters to 86 strikeouts in 143.0 innings of work... ranked third on the Naturals in innings pitched... hurled six innings or more in four consecutive starts from May 4-19, a span in which we went a perfect 3-0... had two spans where he won four straight decisions from May 4-25 and June 29-Aug-1.

In 2007, helped Single-A Wilimngton reach the playoffs, going 9-6 with 3.28 ERA in 26 games (22 starts) and allowing just 119 hits and 33 walks in 131.2 innings of work (1.15 WHIP)... finished ranked third on team in both wins and innings pitched... tossed 10.1 innings in relief with a .087 ERA out of the pen and one save... surrendered only seven long balls in 536 batters faced, good for just one homer every 77 batters.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Blake Wayne Johnson... Originally selected by the Dodgers in the second round of the 2004 First-Year Player Draft... graduated from Parkview Baptist High in Baton Rouge, La. ... was 8-3 with a 1.31 ERA in 12 games as a senior in 2004... struck out 116 batters, allowing just 15 walks and 39 hits in 64 innings.
