'TOPES SQUANDER BIG LEAD IN 14-11 LOSS: The Albuquerque Isotopes saw a 10-2 edge evaporate, the largest lead lost in franchise history, in a 14-11 defeat to the Tucson Padres on Monday night at Isotopes Park. Holding a 10-2 advantage in the sixth, Albuquerque began to watch its lead slip away when the Padres plated five runs in the fifth, three courtesy of a three-run homer by Jeremy Hermida that cut the deficit to 10-7. The 'Topes regained a run in the bottom half of the frame when Alex Castellanos reached on a booted ball by Jedd Gyorko, took third on a double from Josh Fields and scored on a sac-fly from Scott Van Slyke. Following a scoreless seventh and two quick outs in the eighth, the Padres plated seven runs on a mere two hits. Andy Parrino drew a two-out walk, Daniel Robertson singled to right and Gyorko reached on a fielding error, loading the bases. 'Topes reliever Scott Rice then took the mound, immediately yielding three consecutive walks that brought in three runs and allowed Tucson to climb within 11-10. Trailing by one and following the second pitching change of the inning, Vince Belnome blasted a two-out grand slam off Angel Guzman to complete the comeback and give the Padres a 14-11 advantage en route to a come-from-behind victory.

ACE TIME: Looking to snap a two-game losing streak, the 'Topes turn to their ace, right-hander John Ely, who has won three straight games and has vaulted into a tie for the second-most victories in the Pacific Coast League with 11. Another win and Ely will tie for the second most in franchise history with lefty Dana Eveland, who earned 12 victories a year ago, and be just one win shy of the team record of 13, set by Frankie De La Cruz in 2008 and equaled by Giancarlo Alvarado one year later. In his last three starts, all wins, Ely has posted a $2.65 \, \text{ERA}$ ($6 \, \text{ER} / 20.1 \, \text{IP}$) and has fanned 15 while walking just three. In his last two starts at home, the right-hander has been even better, going $2-0 \, \text{with}$ a $2.51 \, \text{ERA}$ ($4 \, \text{ER} / 14.1 \, \text{IP}$).

UP AND ADAM: Tonight the Isotopes welcome Dodgers infielder Adam Kennedy, who is scheduled to make two Major League rehabilitation appearances with the 'Topes while recovering from a strained right groin that landed him on the Disabled List on July 26. In 70 games with LA this year, the big league veteran has batted .250 (36x144) with eight doubles, a triple, a homer and 15 RBI while playing mostly third (33 games) and second (14). Kennedy has already played in five games for Single-A Rancho Cucagmonga on his rehab road, going 4-for-16 (.250) with four runs, a triple, and one RBI. The infielder played two games at second, two games at third, and one as DH for the Quakes. Kennedy is the sixth Dodger to rehab in Albuquerque this year, joining Matt Kemp, Juan Rivera, Jerry Hairston Jr., Ronald Belisario, and Ivan De Jesus Jr. Kennedy is eligible to come off the DL on Friday, August 10.

IT'S ALWAYS TIME FOR TIM: 'Topes All-Star catcher Tim Federowicz has racked up hits in five of his last six games, with four of those being multi-hit performances. In the month of August, Federowicz is 11-for-22 (.500) with five runs, five doubles, and four RBI in six games.

COMFY AT THE TOP: Regardless of what has happened this series, the fact remains the Isotopes are still on top in the Pacific Coast League's American Southern Division and will set a season high for consecutive days in the fabled catbird seat no matter what happens the next two games. Albuquerque is 2.5 games ahead of Oklahoma City and has had at least a share of first place for 18 straight days, one shy of the season high 19 straight days in first set from May 4-23. The American Southern is still the most competitive in the PCL, as Omaha holds a 15-game lead in the American Northern, Reno a 7-game lead in the Pacific Northern, and Sacramento a 5.5-game advantage in the Pacific Southern.

SOUTHERN BELLS: For the second straight season, the Isotopes will have a losing record against teams from the PCL's Pacific Southern Division. With two more games to play, Albuquerque has a combined

southern Division. With two more games to piay, Arouquerque has a comoneur record of 5-9 against Fresno, Las Vegas, Sacramento, and Tucson. Last year, the 'Topes went 7-9 against Pacific Southern Division foes. The last time Albuquerque had a winning record against that division was 2009, when it went 9-7.

SALUTE TO THE 'TOPES!: This afternoon as part of its annual meeting, the Greater Albuquerque Chamber of Commerce held a special salute to the Albuquerque Isotopes for their contributions to the Albuquerque business community over the franchise's 10 seasons. Orbit, the entire team and coaching staff were present at the luncheon, which featured a keynote address by legendary manager Tommy Lasorda.

TODAY'S START: John Ely makes the start coming off his team-leading 11th win of the season on August 2 vs. Las Vegas when he allowed four runs on five hits through 7.0 innings while walking two and striking out four in an 8-5 'Topes win, Ely's third straight triumph. Selected to his first Triple-A All-Star Game and his first since he appeared as a Southern League All-Star in 2009. Pitched a scoreless fourth inning, allowing one walk and striking out two in a 3-0 PCL win. Won a season-high fourth straight game after a victory on June 22 vs. New Orleans when he allowed four runs on five hits in 6.1 innings while walking one and striking out six in an 8-4 Isotopes win in seven-innings. Came two outs away from becoming the first Isotope this season to toss a complete game but surrendered back-to-back home runs that ended his night. Had a streak of six straight quality starts from April 30-May 26. Had a dominant 3-2 win at Tacoma on May 10 when he allowed just two runs on four hits while walking three and striking out a career-high 11, shattering his old career-high of nine set in 2008 when he was at Single-A Winston-Salem in the South Atlantic League. Authored 15.0 scoreless innings in three straight home starts from April 19-May 5. Earned his first victory of 2012, a stellar start on April 19 vs. Iowa when he allowed three runs on six hits in seven innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-3 'Topes win.

2011: Played most of the season in Albuquerque, going 7-8 with a 5.99 ERA (96 ER / 144.1 IP) in 25 starts recalled on April 10 and made a spot start for the Dodgers that day at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres... optioned back to Albuquerque on April 11... nearly threw his first career no-hitter and the first no-hitter in Isotopes history in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20... after holding the I-Cubs hitless going into the seventh and final inning, he struck out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith... then retired the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career... named PCL Pitcher of the Week for April 18-25 thanks to his performance... had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Elv's career. allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in the 3-1 'Topes victory... recalled on June 4 and had a brief stay with the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing of his career - 2007 at Rookie-Level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati... entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win... if he had worked the ninth, he would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA... optioned back to Albuquerque on June 6... had a short stay with the Dodgers after being recalled on August 1 and was inserted into the Los Angeles bullpen, but did not appear in any games before being optioned back to Albuquerque on August 7... recalled one last time on Sept. 6 and made three more relief appearances for Dodgers, not allowing a run in 4.0 innings.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut in 2010, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL)... picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6-June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17-July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from Sept. 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodgers rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-hatter streak in 1981

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins.
