ISOTOPES COME UP SHORT IN 14-10 SHOOTOUT: Jerry Sands and Scott Van Slyke both went yard but it wasn't nearly enough as a seven-run fifth proved the difference in the Albuquerque Isotopes' 14-10 loss to the Omaha Storm Chasers Saturday night at Isotopes Park. Albuquerque hopped to a quick 2-0 lead in the first when Josh Fields slapped a single to short and immediately scored on a monstrous blast to left from Jerry Sands. Omaha wasted little time clawing its way back into the game, plating a run in the second before grabbing a 3-2 lead with a pair of runs in the third. The Chasers added one more in the fourth before the 'Topes came roaring back in the bottom of the frame. Van Slyke sparked the offense with a leadoff solo shot to left that brought the Isotopes within 4-3, followed by back-to-back singles from Alex Castellanos and Josh Bard. Tony Gwynn Jr. then rolled a perfect bunt down the third-base line to advance both runners and Elian Herrera smoked a two-run triple that just stayed fair to give Albuquerque a 5-4 edge. From there, Omaha opened the floodgates, sending 11 batters to the plate en route to a seven-run fifth that featured seven singles, giving Omaha an 11-5 cushion. The Isotopes mounted a small rally in the bottom of the fifth when Bard laced a two-run double to bring Albuquerque within 11-7. Herrera, as part of his three-RBI night, then drove the runner in with a single of his own to narrow the deficit 11-8. Though the comeback was valiant, the 'Topes three runs were quickly nullified in the next frame as the Storm Chasers got three tallies right back to seize a 14-8 lead. In a last-ditch effort at a comeback, Albuquerque tallied two more runs in the seventh but in the end it wasn't enough in an eventual 14-10 Omaha win.

COLE-BLOODED: Tasked with starting the most important game of the Isotopes' season is lefty Cole St. Clair, who is thrust into a spot start with the departure of Albuquerque ace John Ely to Los Angeles. This will be the third start for St. Clair, who made the first start of his professional career earlier this season on July 27 and has acquitted himself rather well in the role. While his record is 0-2 in his two previous starts, the southpaw has posted a respectable 3.38 ERA (4 ER / 10.2 IP) and has pitched through the fifth inning in each outing. Tonight will give St. Clair an opportunity to rebound from a tough August, when he went 0-2 with a 6.30 ERA (14 ER / 20.0 IP) in seven games (one start)

NOT MISSING A BEAT WITH BARD: With All-Star catcher Tim Federowicz headed to Los Angeles yesterday, Josh Bard becomes Albuquerque's everyday backstop, a role the Major League veteran handles with aplomb. In his first game as the starting catcher last night, Bard went 3-for-5 with two runs, a double, and two RBI. That performance was simply a continuation of an ongoing hot streak for the

catcher, who has now hit in each of the last eight games he's played dating back to August 8. Since the streak began, Bard is batting .500 (13x26) with five runs, four doubles and six RBI

SCORCHING THE SCOREBOARD: As you'd expect when two high-caliber offenses square off, runs come in bunches and the 'Topes and Storm Chasers have been racking up tallies all season long. Last night marked the sixth time in 14 games between the two teams that at least one squad has scored double-digits and the fourth time both squads have scored 10 or more times. Combined, Albuquerque and Omaha have averaged a total of 14 runs a game against each other.

ROSTER REDO: Since August 10, the Isotopes roster has undergone 35 separate transactions, including 14 moves over the last six days.

GETTING THE CALL!: Congratulations to former Isotope Ivan De Jesus Jr., who was recalled by the Boston Red Sox today from Triple-A Pawtucket. De Jesus was traded to the Sawx on August 25 as part of the mega-deal that brought Adrian Gonzalez and others to L.A.

MAGIC NUMBER=1!: With some help from the Round Rock Express, who scored five runs in the ninth to beat Oklahoma City last night 6-3, the Isotopes even in defeat saw their magic number shrink to just one. With a 1.5 game lead over the 'Hawks and two to play, an Isotopes win or a RedHawks loss tonight will give Albuquerque it's second division title in four years!

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Split the 2010 season between Single-A Inland Empire and Double-A Chattanooga, going a combined 1-3 with a 4.21 ERA (34 ER / 72.2 IP) and three saves in 44 appearances... struck out 74 batters between both stops... started the season at Inland Empire, going 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER / 12.0 IP) and two saves in eight games... limited opposing hitters to a .167 average (7x42) with 15 strikeouts to earn an April 30 promotion to Chattanooga... saw action in 36 games with the Lookouts, going 1-2 with a 4.60 ERA (31 ER / 60.2 IP) and one save... held opposing hitters to a .211 average (8x38) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

Appeared in 30 games for Single-A Great Lakes in 2009, going 4-1 with a 2.48 ERA (10 ER / 36.1 IP) and 15 saves... did not allow a run over his final 13 appearances (14.0 IP) for the Loons... overall, limited opposing hitters to a .226 average (30x133) with 45 strikeouts in 36.1 innings... successfully converted each of his nine save opportunities... won the August/September Dodger Pride Award for Great Lakes, going 1-0 with seven saves, not allowing a run in 10.0 innings and limiting opponents to a .194 average (7x36) with 11 strikeouts in nine August games.

Selected by the Dodgers in the seventh round of the 2008 draft and began his professional career at Rookie-Level Ogden, posting no record and an 3.18 ERA (6 ER / 17.0 IP) and five saves in 12 games... fanned 22 while walking just five.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Allen Cole St. Clair... went 10-3 with five saves and a 3.03 ERA in 24 games (three starts) as a senior with Rice in 2008... had been selected by Cleveland in the seventh round of the 2007 draft, but chose to return to Rice for his senior season... graduated from Rice with a Bachelor's degree in Economics... was named the winner of the 2008 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, an honor that identifies personal qualities that define a complete student-athlete... was named a *Baseball America* First-Team College All-American after his sophomore season in 2006... pitched for Team USA in 2006, winning the Gold Medal at the FISU World Championships in Havana, Cuba... pitched in three College World Series from 2006-08... was a teammate of Phillip Hughes at Foothill High School in Santa Ana... his father Jay played basketball at the University of Southern California.
