'TOPES HEADED TO PLAYOFFS AFTER 6-5 WIN OVER OMAHA: The Albuquerque Isotopes plated a run in the bottom of the eighth and held on in the ninth to claim a 6-5 playoff-clinching win over the Omaha Storm Chasers at Isotopes Park in front of 14,194 fans, the largest Sunday crowd in franchise history. Trailing 5-4 in the seventh, the 'Topes knotted the contest when Scott Van Slyke lined a single to left and scored on a two-out double off the center field wall from Trent Oeltjen, tying the game 5-5. Following a scoreless top of the eighth, Dee Gordon laid a perfect bunt down the third base line and easily beat out the throw, putting a runner on with one out. Elian Herrera then slapped a single to right, moving the runner to third, and Josh Fields immediately plated the speedy Gordon with a sac-fly in foul territory to right, giving Albuquerque a 6-5 edge. Omaha seemed privy to halting the 'Topes' playoff hopes in the ninth when Irving Falu led off the frame with a double to right and advanced to third on a groundout from Mitch Maier. With only one out and the tying run just 90 feet away, Isotopes closer Josh Wall fanned 'Topes-Killer Max Ramirez and coaxed a flyout from Wil Myers to preserve the lead and pick up his league-best 28th save, while sending Albuquerque to a 6-5 playoff-clinching victory.

THE NEW ADDITION: The 2012 regular season will end with the Isotopes getting their first look at right-hander Lorenzo Barcelo, who will be making his first appearance with Albuquerque after signing yesterday. This will be his first outing in American affiliated baseball since 2003, when he logged 20 relief appearances for Fresno before suddenly retiring from baseball. The right-hander reemerged in 2009 with Tucson in the independent Golden Baseball League. The last three seasons, Barcelo has been a workhorse in the Mexican Summer League leading the circuit in innings-pitched in both 2010 (135.2 IP) and 2011 (142.1 IP). This year Barcelo split time between two teams in Mexico, playing most of the season with Puebla, with whom he went 6-5 with a 3.56 ERA (37 ER / 93.2 IP) in 16 starts and Veracruz, where he posted a 1-0 record with a 2.52 ERA (7 ER / 25.0 IP) in four starts. The right-hander has seen big league time as well, but over a decade ago. Barcelo pitched for the Chicago White Sox in 2000-2002.

PERFECT BOOKENDS: Last night's thrilling win sealed the Isotopes' third division title in franchise history and second in four years. The latest playoff berth comes in the team's 10th season and its first came in the inaugural season of 2003 with a playoff appearance in 2009 thrown in there as well. The next milestone is for the Isotopes to reach the second round for the first time. In 2003, Albuquerque fell in four games to the Nashville Sounds and in 2009, the 'Topes were swept in three games by the Memphis Redbirds, eventual PCL champions.

FAMILIAR FOE: Albuquerque's opponent in the PCL's American Conference Championship will be none other than these very Omaha Storm Chasers, meaning the 'Topes will play at least seven straight games against Omaha, nine if the playoff series goes its full five games. After today's contest, the two teams will travel to Omaha where games one and two of the playoffs will be played at Werner Park on Wednesday, September 5 and Thursday, September 6. The teams will then return to The Lab for game three on Friday, September 7 and games four and five, if necessary, on Saturday and Sunday. In the Pacific Conference Championship, Reno will face perennial powerhouse Sacramento with the winners of both series meeting in the PCL Championship next week.

TOPS IN POP: Thanks in part to 44 total hits over their last three games (an average of 14.7), the Isotopes now lead the Pacific Coast League in team batting average with a mark of .297, mere percentage points ahead of second-place Las Vegas and third place Reno. Technically, the 'Topes team batting average is .29743, while the 51s is .29741, and Reno's is .29651.

QUEST FOR 80: A win in today's regular season finale would give the Isotopes 80 victories on the season, tied with the 2009 club for the most in a single season in franchise history.

HONORARY SKIPPER: PCL Manager of the Year Lorenzo Bundy will turning over the reins today to catcher Josh Bard, who will serve as the team's honorary manager in this afternoon's tilt with Omaha.

TODAY'S START: Righty Lorenzo Barcelo makes his Isotopes debut after splitting his 2012 season between two teams in the Mexican League and signing with the Dodgers as Free Agent on September 2. Began the year with Puebla, going 6-5 with a 3.56 (37 ER / 93.2 IP) in 16 starts. Fanned 58 batters while walking 25. Won three straight decisions from May 4 to May 23, a streak that started with a brilliant outing on vs. Saltillo when he delivered 7.0 shutout innings in which he allowed just six hits in a 9-3 win. Joined Veracruz on July 5 and made three starts, going 1-0 with a 2.52 ERA (7 ER / 25.0 IP).

2011: Led the Mexican League with 142.1 IP while making 21 starts for Puebla... finished 10-7 with a 3.54 ERA (56 ER / 142.1), ninth-lowest in the league... also was second in the circuit with a 1.18 WHIP... tossed a 9.0 inning complete-game shutout on April 18 at Yucatan, allowing just five hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 12-0 Puebla win... was 4-1 with a 2.72 ERA (13 ER / 43.0 IP) in six April starts.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Logged 135.2 innings, tops in the Mexican League, in 21 starts for Puebla... went 11-5 with a 3.65 ERA (55 ER / 135.2 IP), the 10th lowest earned run average in the circuit... fanned 76 while walking just 30... was a perfect 4-0 with a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five May

Appeared in 20 games for Triple-A Fresno in 2003, going 0-0 with a 6.49 ERA (19 ER / 26.1 IP)... retired from baseball until 2009, when he joined Tucson in the independend Golden Baseball League, going 8-5 with a 4.20 ERA (51 ER / 109.1 IP) in 16 starts.

Split the 2002 season between Chicago (AL) and Triple-A Charlotte, his last appearance in the Major Leagues... went 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (6 ER / 6.0 IP) in four games (all in relief) with the White Sox... appeared in just two games (one start) for the Knights, going 0-0 with a 6.75 ERA (4 ER / 5.1 IP).

Appeared in 17 games for Chicago (AL) in 2001, all of which came in relief... went 1-0 with a 4.71 ERA (11 ER / 21.0 IP) for the White Sox... saw action in just two games for Charlotte, posting a 5.40 ERA (3 ER / 5.0 IP).

Made his Major League debut with the White Sox in 2000, appearing in a career-high 22 games (one start)... went 4-2 with a 3.69 ERA (16 ER / 39.0 IP)... also started 17 games for Charlotte that season, going 5-6 with a 4.26 ERA (47 ER / 99.1 IP).

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Lorenzo Antonio Barcelo (bar-cell-O).. signed as an amateur Free Agent by San Francisco in 1994... part of the blockbuster "White Flag Trade" on July 31, 1997 in which Barcelo was sent to the White Sox from the Giants with right-handers Keith Foulke, Bobby Hwory, lefty pitcher Ken Vining, shortstop Mike Caruso, and outfielder Brian Manning, in exchange for lefty Wilson Alvarez, righty Danny Darwin, and right-hander Roberto Hernandez.
