ISOTOPES HOMERS NOT ENOUGH IN 8-4 GAME ONE LOSS: The Albuquerque Isotopes (0-1) mounted a late rally thanks to three home runs, but the Omaha Storm Chasers (1-0) persevered for an 8-4 win the first game of the American Conference Championship Series Wednesday night at Werner Park. Omaha jumped out to a quick lead in the very first inning when Mitch Maier drew a one-out walk, advanced to second on a infield hit by Anthony Seratelli, and was cashed in on a three-run blast by Wil Myers that put the home team up suddenly 3-0. The Chasers struck again in the bottom of a third inning that began with a fielder's choice from Clint Robinson and a walk to Max Ramirez that put runners on first and second with just one down. Will Savage then coaxed Rey Navarro into a groundout to short that was a perfect double-play, but second baseman Elian Herrera threw wildly to first, allowing Robinson to scamper home on the error. Adam Moore followed with a hit to left, plating Navarro and extending the Omaha lead to 5-0. Savage settled down to deliver a scoreless fourth before handing off to Blake Johnson, who was brilliant, shutting down the Storm Chasers for three innings. Josh Bard got the visitors on the board in the fifth with a solo homer to right, trimming the lead to 5-1. An inning later, Herrera reached on an infield hit to short, setting up Jerry Sands, who smashed a two-run homer onto the berm in right field, bringing the Isotopes within 5-3. Josh Fields would then make it a one-run game in the eighth, crushing a line drive that sailed over the fence in right, helping the 'Topes scratch to within 5-4. The Chasers would put the game away in the eighth, however, when Erick Threets unleashed a wild pitch, allowing Maier to score from third, and a dropped catch by Sands on the next batter allowed Seratelli and Myers to come home, sending Omaha to an 8-4 win.

FAMILIAR FIFE: Stephen Fife gets the ball in game two of the PCL American Conference Finals, squaring off against Omaha for the second time in as many starts. The 'Topes right-hander picked up the win against the Storm Chasers on Aug. 31, delivering a shutdown per-

formance in which he allowed two runs, one earned, while walking one and fanning three in a season-high-tying 7.0 innings. Fife worked more frames against the Storm Chasers than any other hurler on Albuquerque's staff during the regular season, 13.2, and despite his 1-2 mark against the opposition, the starter matched up well, posting a respectable 3.29 ERA, the lowest among active Isotopes pitchers that have faced the 'Chasers'

NOT MISSING A BEAT: Following the recall of Isotopes starting catcher Tim Federowicz, veteran Josh Bard has slid into the everyday starting role behind the plate. Bard, who homered in last night's 8-4 loss, has easily risen to the challenge, collecting six hits in his three starts since Sept. 1, including two doubles, two homers and four RBI. The backstop also has the longest active hitting streak for the 'Topes, hitting safely in 10 consecutive games, a span in which Bard has batted a blistering .533 (16x30) with five doubles, two dingers and eight RBI. He has driven in at least one run in each of his last five contests, as well as blasting a home run in back-to-back games.

HOMER HAPPY: Albuquerque blasted three longballs against the Storm Chasers last night, marking the 43rd time this season the Isotopes have hit multiple home runs in a game, as well as the 5th multi-dinger contest against Omaha in 2012. Even more impressive, the performance was the 15th time this year in which the 'Topes have lifted three or more homers in a single game, and was two blasts short of the season-high five, set on July 21 vs. Iowa. In terms of playoff history, the feat tied the franchise record for most home runs in a postseason game, originally set on Sept. 5, 2003 when Robert Stratton, Paul Hoover and Jason Wood each launched a longball in a 12-10 loss to Nashville

**BLAKE BEARS DOWN:** Reliever Blake Johnson tossed 3.0 scoreless innings in yesterday's loss, his second longest scoreless outing of the season. The right-hander has been nearly untouchable through his last six road appearances, posting a 2-1 record while allowing just three runs through 17.1 frames, good for an incredible 1.56 ERA during that stretch.

TODAY'S START: Stephen Fife makes the start coming off a dominant outing against Omaha on Sept. 31 in which he picked up the win while working a season-high-tying 7.0 frames, allowing just two runs, only one that was earned, on six hits. The righty walked one and fanned three in the winning effort. Had his toughest outing of the season at Memphis on August 26 when he pitched just 4.2 innings, allowing six runs on nine hits, including a season-high four homers, while walking one and striking out three in a 7-1 'Topes loss. Had a three-game winning from July 6-August 11, his second such streak of the season. Returned on August 6 from a brief stay with the Dodgers, with whom he made a pair of starts. Suffered his first big league defeat on August 1 vs. Arizona, when he pitched 4.1 innings, allowing two runs on six hits while walking three and striking out four in a 4-0 Dodgers loss. Had a solid no-decision at San Francisco on July 27, pitching 6.1 innings and allowing one run on six hits while walking three and striking out two in a 5-3 LA win in 10 innings. Fanned a season-high 12 on July 22 vs. Iowa, allowing one run on four hits in 7.0 innings in a 9-5 loss. Made his Major League debut with Los Angeles on July 17, when the right-hander filled in for an injured Chad Billingsley. Facing the Philadelphia Phillies, Fife pitched 6.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits and three walks while striking out one. Fife left with a 2-1 lead and in line to get the win, but the Phillies rallied for two runs in the eighth to grab a 3-2 win. The right-hander held the Phillies' quartet of All-Star players Jimmy Rollins, Chase Utley, Ryan Howard, and Carlos Ruiz to a combined 1-for-11. Had his best outing of the season on July 6 vs. Round Rock, when he tossed 7.0 scoreless innings in which he allowed just two hits and two walks while striking out two in a 10-1 'Topes win. Won three straight decisions for the second time this season from May 30 to June 26, posting a 1.50 ERA (3 ER / 18.0 IP) in those starts. Had a shutout performance on May 30 in New Orleans when he tossed 6.0scoreless frames, allowing seven hits and a walk while striking out five in a 4-0 'Topes win. In two starts at New Orleans this year, did not allow a run in 12.0 innings. Tossed 7.0 scoreless innings on May 4 vs. Nashville to extend his streak to 13.0 consecutive innings, fanning a season-high seven in an 8-1 'Topes win. Tied a franchise record by walking eight batters in just 4.2 innings on April 22 at Oklahoma City while allowing five runs on seven hits in an eventual 11-10 'Topes win 14 innings. The eight walks ties knuckleballer Charlie Haeger, who walked eight Omaha Royals in 4.2 innings on June 15, 2010. Enjoyed his first career Triple-A win on April 17 vs. Iowa when he pitched 5.2 innings in which he allowed six runs on 10 hits while walking one and striking out one in a 13-6 win. Also racked up two-hits, including a two-run double in the contest, becoming the first 'Topes pitcher to collect multiple hits in a game since Tim Redding went 2-for-3 on May 9 of last year vs. Memphis and the first to have more than one RBI since J.D. Durbin drove in three in a game vs. Round Rock on Sept. 1, 2009.

2011: Started the season with Double-A Portland (ME) in the Boston organization before he was traded to the Dodgers at the July 31 trade deadline in a four player deal that also sent Tim Federowicz and minor leaguer Juan Rodriguez to L.A. in exchange for Trayvon Robinson... overall, went 14-4 with a 3.74 ERA in 25 combined games (24 starts) with Double-A Chattanooga and Double-A Portland... set new career-bests in wins, innings pitched (137.0) and strikeouts (95)... posted a 3-0 record with a 4.01 ERA (15 ER / 33.2 IP) in six starts after joining Chattanooga... owned a 1-0 record with a 2.45 ERA in three road starts with the Lookouts... went 11-4 with a 3.66 ERA with the Sea Dogs before being traded to the Dodgers... at the time of the trade, his 11 wins were tops amongst all Red Sox farmhands... the 11 victories was tied for second-most in the Eastern League even though he played the last month in the Southern League... selected as a midseason Eastern League All-Star with Double-A Portland after tying for the league lead with 10 first half wins... named the Eastern League's Pitcher of the Week for the period of June 6-13... after taking a no-hitter into the seventh inning in his start on June 7 vs. Richmond... finished the game going 6.1 innings and allowing one hit while fanning seven... notched a career-high nine strikeouts in his July 5 start (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER) at Binghamton... did not allow an earned run in five of 18 starts with Portland... earned the victory in his first start after he was traded to the Dodgers organization, allowing just one run on two hits on August 5 at Jacksonville... following the season, pitched for the Salt River Rafters in the Arizona Fall League.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Stephen J. Fife... played two seasons (2007-08) of college baseball at University of Utah and one at Everett Community College in Washington (2006)... went 7-5 with a 3.72 ERA in 15 starts for the University of Utah as a junior in 2008, leading the team in wins, starts, innings and strikeouts... played in the 1999 Little League World Series.
